- The last column contains the images, graphics, and animations that will occur. The audio narration will align with the image or animation.

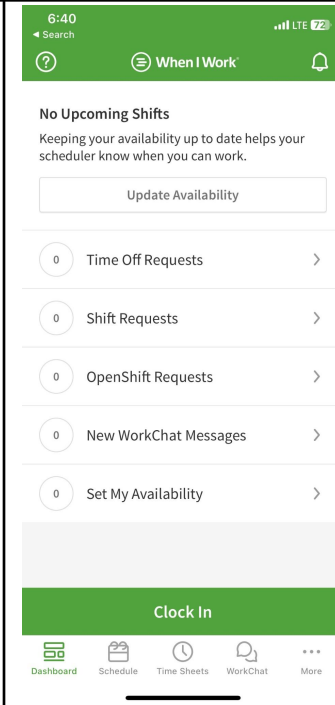

The Zoom will happen in line with the VO.

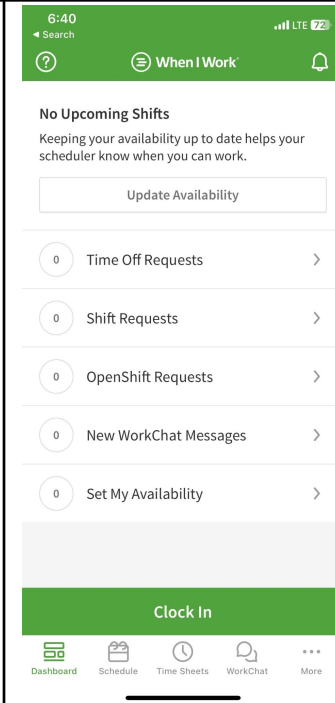
Picture: Dashboard with focus on Clock In

The first key feature you will use is the clock in button. You must clock in to be compensated for your work. Your start time begins when you arrive at Indian Acres. Your stop time may consist of 2 different scenarios. First, at the start of a meal break and last at the end of your shift. Remember, If you are on time, you are late, make sure to be early for your shift so you are ready to receive your campers.

The pan will happen in line with the VO.

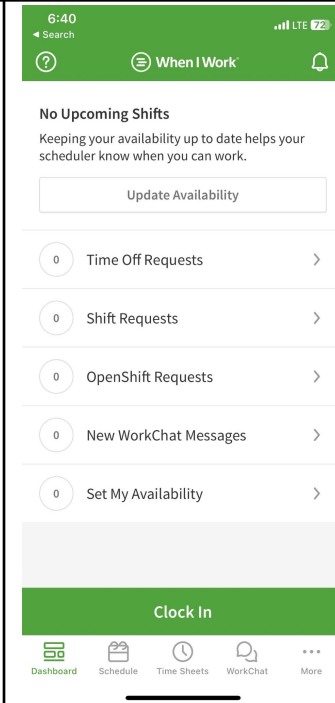
Picture: Dashboard with focus on Schedule

The pan will happen in line with the VO.

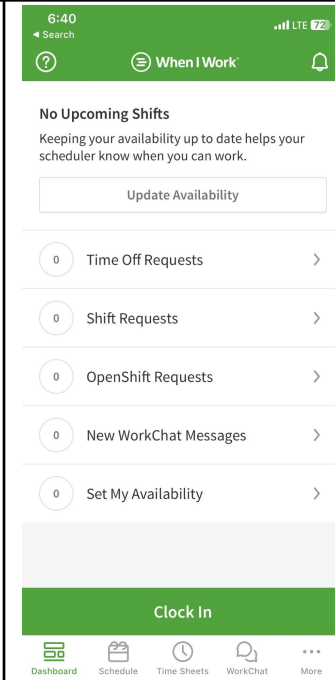
Picture: Dashboard with focus on Time Sheets

The zoom will happen in line with the VO.

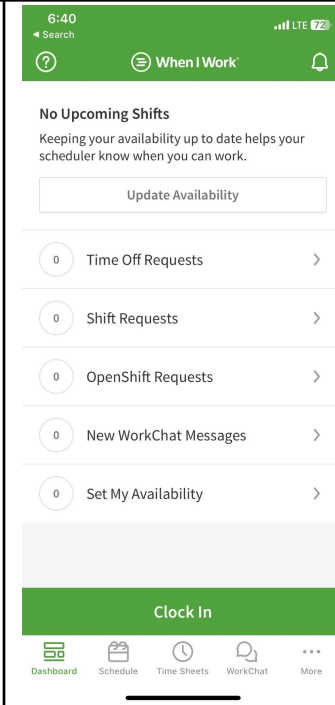
Picture: Dashboard with focus on Work Chat
