- 6. Regatta Description This is a recreational regatta consisting of multiple races.
 - a) The 420 and Sunfish. There will be 2-3 races depending upon conditions.
 - First Race will start in the Yacht Basin and race out the wildlife channel to a finish at ICW Marker 9 across from the Safe Harbor Fuel Dock and a Race Committee Flag on the Dock.
 - ii. Second and Third Races will be from a starting line between ICW Marker 9 and the Safe Harbor Fuel Dock to ICW Marker 2 at Oliver's and finish at the Fuel Dock. Round Marker 2 to your preference.
 - iii. Upon completion of the 3rd race boats return to the Wildlife Basin.
 - b) Opti's
 - i. There will be a triangular course established in the Wildlife Basin. There will be up to 5 two lap races.
 - ii. Upon completion of the 5th race, boats return to the beach.

 - i. 3 minute 3 long whistles
 - ii. 2 minute 2 long
 - iii. 1 minute 30 seconds 1 minute 1 long 3 short
 - iv. 30 seconds 3 short
 - v. 20 seconds 2 short
 - vi. 10 seconds 1 short
 - vii. Last 5 seconds START 5 short (1 per second) 1 long
 - d) A series of short attention signals will be made before beginning of each starting sequence.
