

WEDDING TIMELINE / CHECKLIST

12 MONTHS TO GO

- Announce engagement
- o Arrange for your families to meet if they haven't already
- o Set a budget and determine who will be paying for what
- o Decide what type of wedding you want: style, size, location, time of day, etc.
- o Draft preliminary guest list
- o Register for engagement gifts
- o Gather ideas for you ceremony and reception
- Order thank you notes for engagement gifts
- Subscribe to wedding magazines

11 MONTHS TO GO

- o Plan engagement party
- o Begin dress search
- Set a wedding date
- o Start your venue search
- o Create a wedding website
- o Create a wedding email for only wedding correspondence to keep organized

10 MONTHS TO GO

- Determine your wedding color palette and theme
- o Reserve venue
- Select the members of your bridal party
- o Reserve a block of rooms, Vrbo, AirBnB for yourselves, family, guests or send them links

9 MONTHS TO GO

- Make appointments to try on wedding dresses
- o If wearing an heirloom gown, schedule cleaning and alterations
- o Gather vendor referrals from Wildflower's Preferred Vendor List or on your own
- Choose and interview Officiant
- o Order and mail "Save the Date" cards
- o Start meeting with vendors-photographers, videographers, caterers, DJs, florists, etc.

8 MONTHS TO GO

- o Delegate agreed upon tasks/responsibilities to groom, maid of honor, best man, etc.
- o Contact designer if using

7 MONTHS TO GO

- o Finalize wedding theme and palette
- o Research wedding customs and traditions



WEDDING TIMELINE / CHECKLIST

6 MONTHS TO GO

- o Book baker and decide on cake style, flavor, design
- Book caterer
- o Book florist and determine overall style for bouquets, boutonnieres, ceremony, reception, etc.
- o Book DJ and band
- o Book photographer and videographer
- Finalize guest list and mailing addresses
- o Research invitation designs
- Select and discuss ceremony services with officiant
- o Order wedding dress, grooms attire and accessories
- o Book Wildflower Shuttle Service or other for the wedding night
- Update passports, if needed

5 MONTHS TO GO

- o Select bridesmaid's attire and confirm all have been ordered
- Select attire for flower girl(s) and ring bearer(s)
- o Select attire for groomsmen and confirm all have been ordered
- o Provide bridal shower guest list to maid of honor
- o Research honeymoon destinations
- o Finalize invitation design and order-don't forget to order extra outer envelopes
- o Proof-read invitations
- Use driving directions provided by Wildflower to print on invitations
- o Create a list of Wildflower rental items and other rental items (tents, chairs, etc.)

4 MONTHS TO GO

- O Book honeymoon, purchase plane tickets, etc.
- Meet with hair and makeup artists to discuss ideas and have a practice run-take photos
- Select first dance song and other special dance songs for your DJ
- Order wedding rings

3 MONTHS TO GO

- o Meet with your coordinator to go over all your plans, for the wedding day
- Attend first dress fitting
- o Plan rehearsal dinner, book space, create menu
- o Order/make your wedding favors, if any
- o Purchase guest book or vessel for guest notes
- o Research signature drink options
- o Attend pre-marital counseling classes, if desired
- o Request time off from work for wedding and honeymoon
- o Finalize floral arrangements with florist
- Order wedding programs



WEDDING TIMELINE / CHECKLIST

2 MONTHS TO GO

- o Mail wedding invitations
- o Keep a record of RSVP cards, texts and calls you receive
- Select gifts for attendants and parents
- o Set aside gratuities for vendors
- Attend bridal shower
- o Write and mail shower thank-you notes
- o Start drafting your wedding vows if writing your own
- o Schedule tastings with your caterer and baker and confirm menus/flavors
- o Send wedding announcement to newspapers, if desired

1 MONTH TO GO

- Draft seating chart, if using
- Apply for a marriage license
- O Compile a list of desired photos/poses to photographer-send to them
- Create song playlist and song NOT to be played for your DJ/band-send to them
- Attend bachelor/bachelorette parties
- o Have your maid of honor, best man, parents, etc. prep their speeches
- o Bride and groom, start breaking in your wedding day shoes
- o Schedule a haircut appt for the groom 2 weeks before the wedding day
- o Find something old, new, borrowed and blue
- Attend final dress fitting
- o Pick up your wedding rings
- o Finalize and create seating chart/place cards

1 WEEK TO GO

- Pick up wedding dress
- o Have groom and groomsmen pick up their attire, iron/steam and hang
- o Give caterer and coordinator your final guest count
- o Give bridesmaids and groomsmen your coordinator's phone number
- o Confirm hair and makeup appointments, location and time
- o Pack for honeymoon
- Assign any day-of responsibilities to attendants

DAY OF WEDDING

- o MAKE SURE YOU ARE ON TIME FOR YOUR HAIR/MAKEUP APPOINTMENT AND BEGINNING OF HOTOGRAPHS-this will dictate scheduling for the remainder of the day
- o Make sure you are hydrated and eat breakfast, lunch and a snack right before the ceremony
- Relax knowing your coordinator has everything under control-it is THEIR job, not yours, to make sure all scheduled events run smoothy
- o Relax, don't sweat if any hiccups occur-you're marrying the love of your life!
