ABOUT THE EVENT

EconoQuest is an **international economics education program** for high school students. The multi-day conference provides a unique opportunity for Montana high school students to engage with local businesses, government officials and international leaders. Students explore and discuss the **impact of global affairs on Montana's economy** and learn about career opportunities in the state. In 2024, 200 students attended the in-person EconoQuest Conference held at Montana State University. Students gained first-hand knowledge of key Montana industries, economic theory and international trade.

In addition to the in-person conference, EconoQuest includes a **virtual program** designed for both middle school and high school students. More than 1000 Montana students participated during the 2024/2025 school year. Industries introduced to students were Photonics and Quantum, Cloud Computing, Agriculture, Outdoor Economy, Semiconductors, Manufacturing, Bioscience, and Energy and Extractives. **EconoQuest is offered free to all students**, including scholarships for lodging, transportation, meals and substitute teacher expenses.

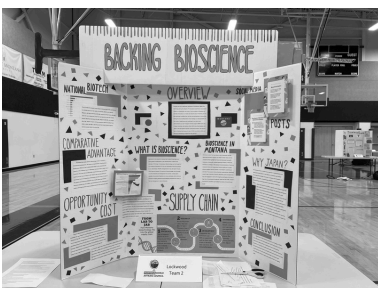
