- 1. Historical issue and insufficient progress
- 2. a. Absence of comprehensive assessment process
 - b. Absence of systematic assessment process
- 3. Reliance on survey data and course evaluation (includes grades) to document student learning
- 4. Lack of linkage of assessment to institutional planning, budgeting, and funding priorities
- 5. Limited/lack of faculty involvement
- 6. No or limited evidence/documentation of data utilization to improve student learning
- 7. Lack of assessment of co-curricular activities
- 8. Program learning goals (outcomes) were not clear
- 9. Lack of linkage of course objectives to program outcomes or college level assessment
