

Graduate Survey 2023 Results Overview

Purpose

Graduation is an important data collection point to assess the students' perceptions of the CASC Learning Experience. The graduate exit survey is designed to collect student feedback on the following primary questions:

- What are the students' future plans after graduation?
- To what extent did their experience at CASC contribute to their knowledge, skills, and personal development?
- How satisfied are the students with the learning experience?

Continuous Improvement – How can we do it better?

- Based on identified strengths and challenges, how can we improve the CASC Experience?

Survey Context

The 2023 Graduate Survey was administered via email to fall 2022 graduates and soon-to-be spring 2023 graduates. The survey launched on April 19, 2023, and concluded on May 15, 2023. A total of 248 students out of 382 completed the survey, which calculates into a favorable 65% response rate.


