Q: Why is basic HTTPS not enough for my law firm's website?

A: While HTTPS encrypts data between your website and visitors, it doesn't protect against compromised website files, unauthorized CMS access, data breaches through vulnerable plugins, or social engineering attacks. For legal practices, this leaves client information vulnerable and can lead to professional liability.

Q: What are the main cybersecurity threats facing law firms today?

A: Threat actors specifically target law firms due to the value of information. Key threats include AI-enhanced social engineering (phishing), supply chain vulnerabilities through third-party integrations, and increasing regulatory scrutiny requiring Data Protection Impact Assessments.
