Between **March 10 and May 4, 2025**, American Jews will vote for their vision of the Jewish people in Israel and around the world. Make sure your point of view is represented in the **39th World Zionist Congress.** Choose one of the many slates representing diverse political beliefs, religious denominations and cultural traditions. The 152 delegates elected from the United States will join hundreds from Israel and around the world at the 39th World Zionist Congress in October 2025, the international "parliament of the Jewish people", to make decisions and set policies regarding key institutions that support global Jewish life and which allocate over \$1 Billion annually to support Israel and World Jewry (including the World Zionist Organization, Jewish National Fund/Keren Kayement Leyisrael and the Jewish Agency for Israel).

Who Can Vote?

To be eligible to vote in the U.S. election for the 39th World Zionist Congress, you must:

- Be Jewish (and not subscribe to another religion)
- Be 18 years or older by June 30, 2025
- Be a U.S. citizen or a legal permanent resident in the U.S.
- Maintain your primary residence in the U.S.
- Accept the Jerusalem Program (the Zionist movement platform) see text on page 2
- Have not voted in the November 2022 Knesset election (and will not vote in any future Knesset election which may be held prior to July 28, 2025)

How to Register

- 1. Please complete the form and sign your name where indicated. All required personal information must be completed in full. Print in clear block letters. Illegible or incomplete forms will not be processed. The selection and signatures must be made by ink pen and cannot be completed digitally.
- 2. Payment must be made by credit card or personal check payable to: American Zionist Movement. Business checks and credit cards, gift cards, cash or money orders will not be accepted.
- 3. Return both page 2 (registration) and page 3 (ballot) together in one envelope.

The Jerusalem Program - The Zionist movement platform

The JERUSALEM PROGRAM is the official platform of the World Zionist Organization and the global Zionist movement, and states that: Zionism, the national liberation movement of the Jewish people, brought about the establishment of the State of Israel, and views a Jewish, Zionist, democratic and secure State of Israel to be the expression of the common responsibility of the Jewish people for its continuity and future.

- 1. The unity of the Jewish people, its bond to its historic homeland Eretz Yisrael, and the centrality of the State of Israel and Jerusalem, its capital, in the life of the nation;
- 2. Aliyah to Israel from all countries and the effective integration of all immigrants into Israeli society.
- 3. Strengthening Israel as a Jewish, Zionist and democratic state and shaping it as an exemplary society with a unique moral and spiritual character, marked by mutual respect for the multi-faceted Jewish people, rooted in the vision of the prophets, striving for peace and contributing to the betterment of the world.
- 4. Ensuring the future and the distinctiveness of the Jewish people by furthering Jewish, Hebrew and Zionist education, fostering spiritual and cultural values and teaching Hebrew as the national language; Nurturing mutual Jewish responsibility, defending the rights of Jews as individuals and as a nation, representing the national Zionist interests of the Jewish people, and struggling against all manifestations of anti-Semitism;
- 5. Settling the country as an expression of practical Zionism.
- 6. Encouraging recruitment and service in the Israel Defense Forces and the security forces and strengthening them as the protective force of the Jewish people living in Zion, as well as encouraging full National Service for anyone exempted in law from service in the IDF.

Registration Fee All fields are required

The voter registration is \$5 (which covers administrative costs of running the election). Payment must be by personal check, credit or debit card. Make checks payable to American Zionist Movement or use your personal credit card (corporate cards & gift cards are not permitted). Payments by cash or money order are not accepted. No more than four (4) other family members at your address may use this same payment method.


