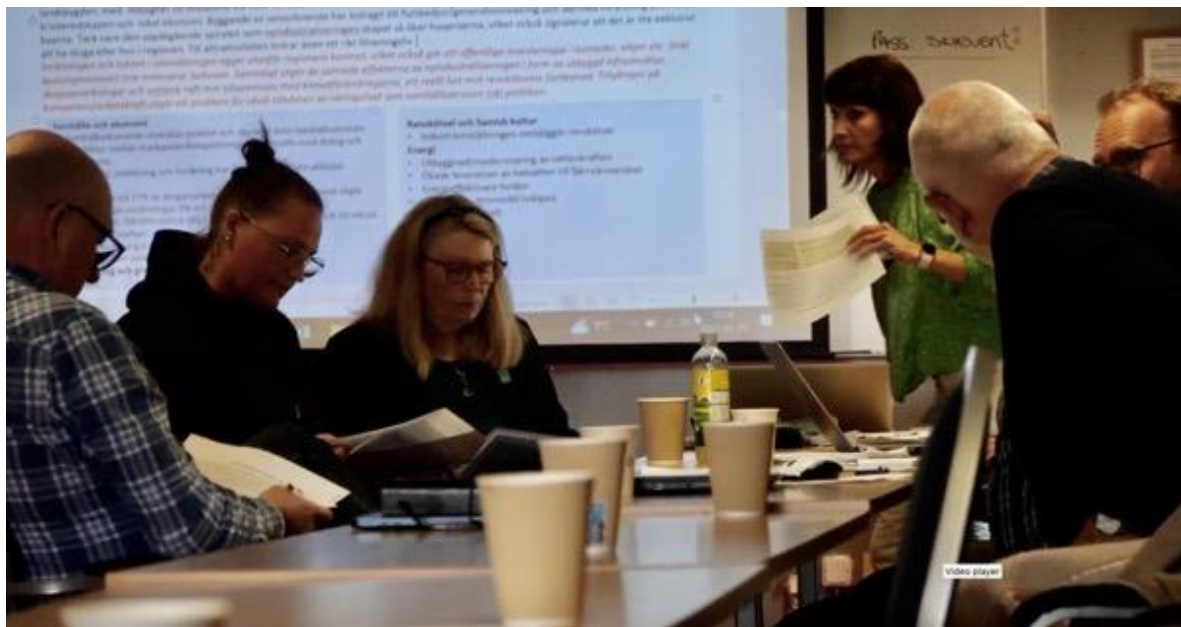


IN SEARCH OF SOLUTIONS TO ONGOING LAND-USE CONFLICTS

Implementation of participatory tools (Ptools) in ArcticHubs



Funded through the **EU Horizon 2020** programme, ArcticHubs project has a core objective to develop research-led, practice-based solutions to help address the urgent challenges faced in the Arctic. The ArcticHubs project is seeking to move towards resolving conflicts over land and sea resources in the region notably by using new adaptive tools and approaches.

The primary goal of ArcticHubs **WP4** is to develop and improve such tools for data collection, communication and to support impact assessments or help envisage future scenarios. The project recognises the importance of co-designing such solutions with locals and Arctic stakeholders and has adopted an appropriate suite of tools that have evolved and been adapted throughout the project.

The WP4 webinar provides an ideal opportunity to consider the processes and journeys those different Ptools have taken during the project, and consider how they have been used to improve dialogue among involved stakeholders.
