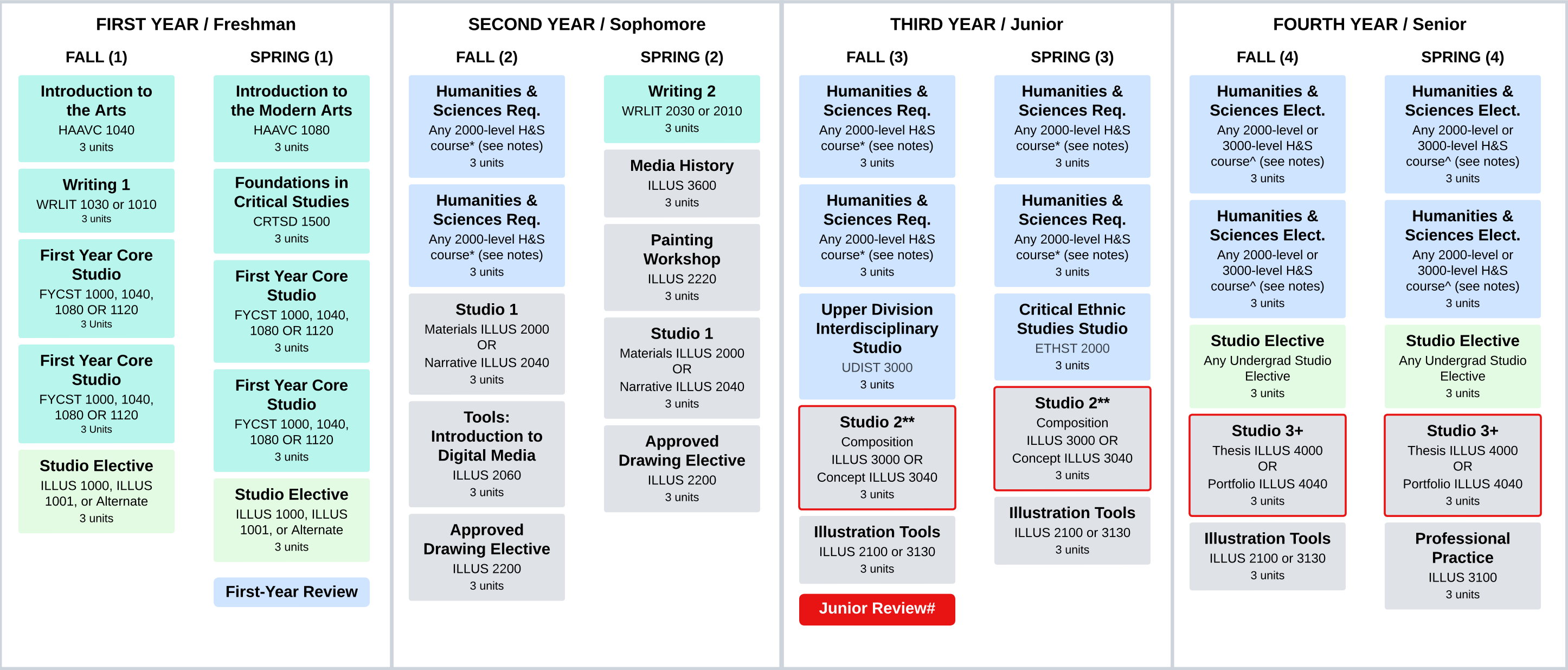

# Illustration (BFA)

This chart outlines a recommended path towards graduation for students matriculating in Fall 2025 or Spring 2026. Students build each semester's schedule based on their remaining requirements found in Workday Student.

\*Foundational and Program-Specific Curricula must be completed with a grade of C or better.

Pre-requisites and co-requisites are shown as general guidelines for program-specific courses and this chart may not include all components of a course's eligibility rule. Eligibility requirements are not shown for Foundational or College-wide curricula. Students should check Workday for all eligibility requirements and consult with Academic Advising as needed.

- \*Humanities & Sciences Requirements, 2000-level:** Illustration students complete 3 units at the 2000-level from each of the six Humanities & Sciences Categories: ETHSM, HAAVC, LITPA, PHCRT, SSHIS, SCIMA.
  - ^Humanities & Sciences Electives, 2000- or 3000-level:** In addition to the Humanities & Sciences Requirements, Illustration students complete four additional Humanities & Sciences courses which are chosen from among the six Humanities & Sciences Categories. At least two of the courses (6 Units) must be at the 3000-level.
  - ~First-Year Review:** Illustration students participate in First-Year Review in the Spring semester as a capstone event of their First-Year experience.
  - #Junior Review:** Illustration students must complete a Junior Portfolio Review during the second semester of their Third Year to continue on to their Fourth Year.

**\*\*Studio 2** To be eligible for Studio 2, Illustration students must have successfully completed Materials ILLUS 2000, Narrative ILLUS 2040, Introduction to Digital Media ILLUS 2060, Painting Workshop ILLUS 2220, and Media History ILLUS 3600, plus 2 approved drawing electives.

**+Studio 3** To be eligible for Studio 3, Illustration students must have successfully completed Composition ILLUS 3000 and Concept ILLUS 3040.
