NOTES:

***Humanities & Sciences Requirements, 2000-level:** Interdisciplinary students complete 3 units at the 2000-level from each of the six Humanities & Sciences Categories: ETHSM, HAAVC, LITPA, PHCRT, SSHIS, SCIMA.

^Humanities & Sciences Electives, 2000- or 3000-level: In addition to the Humanities & Sciences Requirements, Interdisciplinary students complete four additional Humanities & Sciences courses which are chosen from among the six Humanities & Sciences Categories. At least two of the courses (6 Units) must be at the 3000-level.

~First-Year Review: Interdisciplinary students participate in First-Year Review in the Spring semester as a capstone event of their First-Year experience.

#Sophomore and Junior Reviews: Interdisciplinary students must complete a Sophomore Portfolio Review during the second semester of their second year and a Junior Portfolio Review during the second semester of their Third Year to continue on in the program.
