### STUDIO ACCESS

Studio Access Hours:	Open with Building Access: daily 7am-12 midnight
General Orientation and Access:	Must be currently enrolled in a Sculpture course or have documented permission by the Fabrication Studio Managers and program Chairs.
Equipment use:	All manual, electric, and pneumatic hand tools are permitted in the space, with the exception of powered sanding and grinding tools, which must be used in the Finishing Room (D126) or Grinding Room (D133A) depending on the material being worked with.
Cleanup Process:	All students must clean their workspace, including sweeping tables and floors. Additionally, ensure that your project work is stored only in approved locations. Maintaining a clean workspace is essential for safety and ensures the studio remains accessible for all users.

### SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

Attire Requirements:	When using rotary power tools (such as drills), loose hair must be tied back along with loose clothing/jewelry. Closed-toed shoes are required when working with heavy objects or sharp tools. Eye and ear protection are required when hazards are present.
Food and drink policy:	Food and drink should be covered to prevent contamination.

### MATERIALS USE

Materials Storage:	Temporary storage is reserved for students currently enrolled in a Sculpture course only. All work and materials must be disposed of after final presentations. Any projects left behind without prior approval from Faculty and Studio Management will be thrown away.
Materials Disposal:	Recycle in accordance with posted city and county recycling guidelines. Usable scrap material should be placed on the designated shelving. All other landfill trash can go in the gray or black trash bins. Debris that does not fit in the trash cans must be disposed of in the dumpsters located behind the Double Ground building. Ask studio management for guidance. <b>Food waste should be disposed of in green compost bins outside the shops.</b>
Banned Materials:	<b>Spray adhesive may not be used anywhere on campus. Fiberglass may not be used anywhere on campus. Two-part polyurethane foam may not be mixed or used anywhere on campus.</b>
