STUDIO ACCESS

Studio Access Hours:	Open with building access: daily 7am-12 midnight
General Orientation and Access:	The Textiles Weaving Studio is open to students who are currently registered in a class scheduled to work in that space or have contacted the studio manager for loom access. Textiles majors and advanced Textiles students can use the space and equipment with the permission of the studio manager. Access must also be cleared by faculty if a student is seeking access while a class is actively working in the space.
Special Equipment Authorization:	Must be enrolled in a class or have previously taken a weaving class.

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

PPE Requirements:	No chemicals or wet processes are allowed in this studio. Students are responsible for keeping their workspace clean and keeping aisles and walkways clear for access and emergency egress.
Room Requirements:	Project work may not occur in the egress walkways located outside in the Atrium.
Attire Requirements:	N/A
Headphones/earbuds:	Headphones and earbuds are permitted in this studio.
Food and drink policy:	No eating in the Weaving Studio. Water must be covered at all times and kept off the equipment.

MATERIALS USE

Materials Storage:	Projects must be labeled with name and date, and may be stored in specified areas designated by the studio manager.
Materials Disposal:	Donate usable leftover materials into Free Bin. Put scrap yarn in the bucket near the entrance. Debris and recycling that does not fit in the studio trash cans must be disposed of in the lidded containers located in the Atrium. Ask studio management for guidance. Food waste should be disposed of in green compost bins outside the shops.
Banned Materials:	Check with the studio manager when bringing in outside materials. Spray adhesive may not be used anywhere on campus.
