## FUN FACTS ■ GET THE CONVERSATION STARTED

- Moses' story began when he was born in Egypt, four hundred years and many generations after Joseph's family had settled there.
- After Moses left Egypt, God used a burning bush in the desert to get his attention and call him back to the place where his people continued to live in slavery.
- God used Moses to free the Hebrew people from slavery and, ultimately, lead them to the Promised Land.

# THINGS TO DO AT HOME



**A BLESSING TO PRAY OVER YOUR CHILD**  
(Child's name), may you always know that God is bigger than every fear you face and that He is always with you.

**FAMILY TIME ■ HOMEWORK (RETURN NEXT WEEK FOR A PRIZE)**

Ask your children to show you the biggest thing they can find in your home. Then ask them, "How big do you think God is? Is there anything He can't do?" Share with your children that there was a man in the Bible named Moses. God used Moses in some really big ways. Then read Exodus 4:1-14. After reading the Scripture passage, answer these questions together:

- How do you think Moses felt when God spoke to him through the burning bush? \_\_\_\_\_
- How did God show Moses He is "bigger" than anything he was facing? \_\_\_\_\_
- Do you believe God is "bigger" than anything you might face? \_\_\_\_\_

Look for opportunities to bring conversations about how God is bigger into your everyday life as a family.
