PRIVACY POLICY

CCDEX Technologies, Ltd. ("CCDEX", "We", "Our", "Us") are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. This policy should be read together with our Terms and Conditions Agreement and we adopt the terms defined there in this policy.

This policy sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, that you provide to us, or that is provided to us by a subscriber to our services (under the brand name CCDEX), will be processed by us. Please read the following carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it. Information We May Collect From You

The collection of personal information shall be limited to that which is necessary for the purposes we identify. This information will be collected by fair and lawful means:

- Information you give us. You may give us information about you by filling in forms on our CCDEX Websites or by corresponding with us by phone, e-mail or otherwise. This includes information you provide when you register to use our site, subscribe to our service, participate in any discussion boards, forums or other social media functions on our site or enter a competition, promotion or survey and when you report a problem with our site. The information you give us may include your name, address, e-mail address and phone number, financial and credit card information, personal description and photograph. We also store the Content that you upload or provide to the Service in order to provide you with the features and functionality of the Service.
- Information we receive from other sources. Cookies

Tracking Technologies

We may receive reports based on the use of these technologies by these companies on an individual as well as aggregated basis.

Analytics/Log Files

Log Files – As is true of most web sites, we gather certain information automatically and store it in log files. We may combine this automatically collected log information with other information we collect about you. We do this to improve services we offer you, to improve marketing, analytics, or site functionality.

Uses Made of the Information

Personal information will not be used or disclosed for purposes other than those for which it was collected:

- Information you give to us. We will use this information:

 - to provide you with information about other goods and services we or our third party affiliates or business partners offer;
 - to provide you with information about goods or services we feel may interest you, including providing you with information about goods and services similar to those which were the subject of a previous sale or negotiations of a sale to you. If you are a new customer we may contact you by electronic means:
 - to notify you about changes to our service; and

- o to ensure that content from our site is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer.
- Information we collect about you. We will use this information:
 - to carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered into between a Subscriber and use;
 - to administer our site and for internal operations, including troubleshooting, data analysis, testing, research, statistical and survey purposes;
 - to improve our site to ensure that content is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer;
 - to allow you to participate in interactive features of our services, when you choose to do so;
 - o as part of our efforts to keep our site safe and secure;
 - to measure or understand the effectiveness of advertising we serve to you and others, and to deliver relevant advertising to you;
 - to provide you with information about other goods and services we or our third party affiliates or business partners offer;
 - o to make suggestions and recommendations to you, Subscribers and other users of our site about goods of services that may interest you or them.
- Information we receive from other sources. We may combine this information with information you give us and information we collect from you. We may use this information and the combined information for the purposes set out above (depending on the types of information we receive).

Disclosure of Your Information

We may share your personal information with any member of our group, which includes our subsidiaries, affiliates, business partners, agents, and other designated third parties.

We will not share personal information about you or any Content with any third parties except as described in this Privacy Policy or in connection with the Services. Data we share with third parties may be in aggregate form or maybe personally identifiable. We may share your information with selected third parties, including:

- Business partners, vendors, suppliers and subcontractors for the performance of any contract we enter into with you or a corporate entity which is a subscriber.

 companies and organizations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk
 reduction.
- If CCDEX is involved in a merger, acquisition, or sale of all or a portion of its assets, you will be notified via email and/or a prominent notice on our Web site of any change in ownership or uses of your personal information, as well as any choices you may have regarding your personal information.

Some of our pages utilize framing techniques to serve content to/from our partners while preserving the look and feel of our site. Please be aware that you are providing your personal information to third parties and not to CCDEX.
