

ADMISSIONS POLICY

- Must be 17 years of age or older
- Attend the school orientation
- High school diploma, equivalency or GED. *Students who received their high school diploma or equivalent from a foreign country MUST submit an official English translation.
- A tuberculosis screening result must be provided at registration/admission
- Students will be required to take a random drug test
- The student must give the school permission to run a background check for criminal history
- Applicants must provide proof of hepatitis series B and updated childhood immunization records, or complete and sign an exemption waiver. The school strongly suggests completing the vaccination series (Ref. programs that require immunization records and cannot accept waiver)
- Satisfy prerequisites for programs (if applicable) prior to enrolling

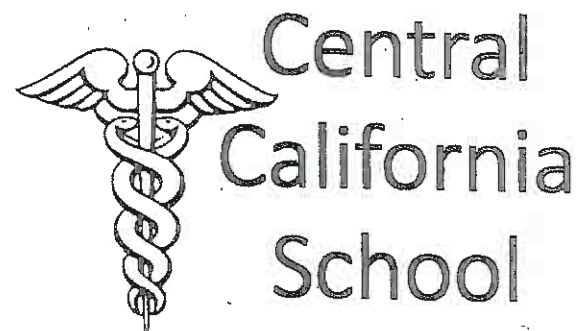

Dental Assistant

Graduates will be qualified to take dental x-rays and assist the dentist, as well as being able to perform front and back office duties. This program includes practical experience in an externship site.

Program Length:

9 Months

41.5 Quarter Credit Hours

Tuition:

\$9,800 – All training materials are included in tuition cost

Medical Assistant

The student is taught business office procedures, clinical skills, and practical experience in an externship site. Graduates are eligible to take the National Medical Assistant Certification Examination.

Program Length:

9 Months

45 Quarter Credit Hours

Tuition:

\$9,800 – All training materials are included in tuition cost

X-Ray Technician/Medical Assistant

Combines the X-Ray Technician program with the clinical portion of the Medical Assistant program. The graduate will be eligible to sit for the Certification Examination for Medical Assistant and the State Board Exams for X-Ray Technician.

Program Length:

12 Months

51 Quarter Credit Hours

Tuition:

\$14,000 – All training materials are included in tuition cost

X-Ray Technician

The student is trained to take x-rays for permits of chest, torsoskeletal, and extremities acquiring 350 x-rays for anatomical areas of the body to be eligible to sit for the California Radiation Health Branch State Board Examination.

Prerequisite:

Candidates MUST have a medically related background and/or documented training in the medical field

Program Length:

10 Months

35.5 Quarter Credit Hours

Tuition:

\$13,000 – All training materials are included in tuition cost

Diagnostic Medical Ultrasound

Prepares students for an entry-level position as an ultrasonographer for an imaging center, hospital or other medical facility.

Program Includes:

Clinical medical assistant, operation of the ultrasound machine, scanning the body for imaging (Abd, and OB/GYN) and the physics of ultrasound.

Program Length:

18 Months

106 Quarter Credit Hours

Tuition:

\$18,240 (divided into two parts at \$9,120 per part) – All training materials are included in tuition cost

Diagnostic Medical Vascular Ultrasound

Provides the necessary education and scanning skills to perform entry-level Medical Vascular Diagnostic Ultrasonographer duties and/or Ultrasound Technician Assistant in vascular specialties.

Prerequisite:

Candidates MUST have already completed a basic Diagnostic Ultrasound Program.

Program Length:

9 Months
