ADMISSIONS POLICY

- Must be 17 years of age or older
- Attend the School's Orientation
- Submit a high school Diploma, GED or equivalent.
- If from a foreign country, have an English translated transcript.
- Provide at registration, a negative TB test result.
- If program has prerequisite students need to provide them upon enrollment.

DENTAL ASSISTANT

Graduates will be qualified to take dental x-rays and assist the dentist. They will be able to perform front office and back office duties. This program includes practical experience in an externship site. (41.5 quarter credit hours)

9 Months

Tuition: \$10,000

MEDICAL ASSISTANT

The student is taught business office procedures, clinical skills and practical experience in an externship site. Graduates are eligible to take the National Medical Assistant Certification Examination. (45 quarter credit hours)

9 Months

Tuition: \$9,900 (includes test fee)

X-RAY TECHNICIAN/ MEDICAL ASSISTANT

Combines the X-ray Technician Program with the clinical portion of Medical Assistant. The graduate will be eligible to sit for the National Certification Exam for Medical Assistant and the California Board Exams for X-ray Technician. (51 quarter credit hours)

12 Months

Tuition \$15,000 (includes test fees)

X-RAY TECHNICIAN

The student is trained to take x-rays for permits of Chest, Spine and Extremities. Upon completion will take the California State Board Exam for X-ray Technician. (38 quarter credit hours) 10 Months,

Tuition \$ 14,000 (includes test fees)

Prerequisite: must be currently working in a Medical Office where there is a registered X-ray machine, to complete clinical training.

DIAGNOSTIC MEDICAL ULTRASOUND

Prepares the student for an entry-level position as an Ultrasound Technician, or Assistant plus Clinical Medical Assistant, for an imaging center, hospital or other medical facility. Includes clinical medical assistant, operation of the ultrasound machine, scanning the body for imaging (abdominal, ob/gyn & small body parts) plus physics of ultrasound.

(106 quarter credit hours)

18 Months

Tuition: \$19,000 (divided into two parts at \$9,500 per part)

There is a non-refundable registration fee of \$75 for all programs.

DIAGNOSTIC MEDICAL

VASCULAR ULTRASOUND

Provides the necessary education and scanning skills to perform entry-level Medical Vascular Diagnostic Ultrasound, and/or Ultrasound Technician Assistant in vascular specialties. Students must have already completed the basic Diagnostic Medical Ultrasound Program.

(60 quarter credit hours)

9 Months

Tuition: \$12,000
