CCSCE acknowledges that the School Director signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that CCSCE has used no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004 (a) (1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students. The total amount of funds the institution received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students was \$326,010. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under Section 1800 (a) (1) of the CARES Act as of the date of submission was \$163,005. (i.e., as of the 30 day Report and every 45 days there after). The estimated total number of students at CCSCE is 57 who were eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 1800 (a) (1) of the CARES Act. The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under Section 1800(a)(1) of the CARES Act was 57. The method used by CCSCE to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants, was determined by those that had a 19/20 ISIR on file and were affected by not having In person training. These students had to be in the Student body from Mar.1, thru June 1, 2020 and were affected by the interruption of training. They had to be In good academic standing. The money received was for the purpose of being used for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to the coronavirus.
