First Time in Sri Lanka

The apprenticeship model consists of an inclusive curriculum with an intense weekly 2-day theoretical and practical learning followed by a comprehensive 4-day 'on-the-job' training that will distinct SHMA graduates as trailblazers and gamechangers in the industry.

This was successfully introduced through the VET by EHL Pilot Program in March 2021 with a batch of 19 students who are following the apprenticeship model at SHMA Partner hotels; Cinnamon Grand, Cinnamon Lakeside, Taj Samudra, Galle Face Hotel and Shangri-La, Colombo.

SHMA is the first hospitality management institute in Sri Lanka to offer an apprenticeship model through the VET by EHL programs, heralding a revolutionary change to the hospitality industry.
