PARTICIPATION

Participants invited according to individual arrangements with the organizer. The projected average FIDE rating of the tournament is 2500-2550

TOURNAMENT RULES

Tournament will be played in the round robin system, 9 rounds.

Rate of game: 90 min/40 moves + 30 minutes for the rest of the game with an increment of 30 seconds per move, starting from move 1.

The current FIDE rules apply. Players may only agree to a draw after the 30th move has been made by black. The default time is 30 minutes.

The order of players that finish with the same number of points shall be determined by application of the following tie-breaks: direct encounter, the greater number of wins, Sonneborn-Berger, the Extended Koya System.

PRIZES

1st place - 6000 PLN

2nd place - 4000 PLN 3rd place - 2000 PLN

4th place - 1500 PLN

5th place - 1000 PLN

The prizes are not shared. Money prizes are given in gross amounts.

According to Polish law, prizes up to 2000 PLN are untaxed, while a 10% tax applies on all other prizes.
