

NAME OF ACTIVITY- Alphabet Sound Game

Activity Intro- Give your child the opportunity to reinforce the sounds of the letters of the alphabet through this fun game.

Activity Aims- Observation, Alphabet Sound Thinking skills, Alphabet recognition, Gross motor skills development

Material Required

Counter/Coin

Glue

Activity Sheets

Steps:

Step 1

Take out the 'Alphabet Sound Game - Mat' sheets.
Glue the two sheets together to get a complete 'Alphabet Sound Game - Mat'.

Step 2

Take out the 'Alphabet Sound Game - Letter Cards'. Cut along the dotted lines to get separate cards.

Step 3

Before you start the game revise the name and sound of each letter of the alphabet using the flashcards with your child.

Step 4

Ask your child to sit at the foot of the mat but not facing the mat.

Step 5

Give your child a plastic counter or a coin & ask him/her to throw it gently on the mat.

Step 6

Let your child name the picture the counter falls on.

Step 7

Let your child identify the picture and say the name and the sound of letter the picture begins with.

Ask your child to pick up the corresponding letter card & put it on the picture.

Step 8

Continue the game until all the pictures are covered with the alphabet cards.

NAME OF ACTIVITY- More Or Less Activity

Activity Intro

An simple and fun activity to make your child understand the concept of more or less.

Material Required

-Scissors

Activity Aim: Observation Thinking skills, Comparison, Fine motor development, Concept of more and less

Step 1

Take out the More or Less mat and the more or less activity sheet. Cut along the dotted lines to get separate fish cards.

Step 2

Give your child the mat and the fish cards, ask him to count and put 7 fish in one aquarium & 13 fish in the other.

Step 3

Let your child tell you which has more, which has less.

Step 4


Continue the activity by varying the number of fish in each jar until your child understands the concept of more and less.





NAME OF ACTIVITY- Summer Time Food Pattern

Activity Intro: A simple pattern worksheet to let your child know about summertime treats.

Material Required: -

-Summer time food pattern activity sheet

Activity Aim Tag: Pattern recognization, Seasons, Logical thinking

Step 1:

Take out the activity sheet and cut along the dotted lines given below the worksheet to get separate picture counters.

Step 2

Let your child observe the activity sheet and identify the objects in each row. Help your child to notice the pattern in the first row, for example - mango, strawberry, orange, watermelon, mango, strawberry, orange, — ask your child what should come next. If your child cannot answer correctly then help him with the correct answer. Explain the sequence again to him.


Step 3

Once your child has understood the concept let your child glue the picture counters in the correct place to complete the patterns.

NAME OF ACTIVITY- Rainy Day - Sequencing

Activity Intro: Rainy day calls for playing outside & having fun. Get your child to sequence what they do on a rainy day.

Material Required

-Scissors

Activity Aim Tag: Seasons, Learning to sequence Logical Thinking

Step 1

Take out the rainy season sequencing sheet.

Cut along the dotted lines to get separate sequencing cards.

Step 2

Ask your child to observe the pictures on each card and talk about it. Help your child by asking simple questions about the pictures on each card. Then ask your child to make up a story using the sequencing cards.



Rainy Day Sequencing




























NAME OF ACTIVITY- Sorting The Clothes By Seasons

Material Required

Activity Aim Tag: Learning to sort Seasons, Thinking skills

Step 1

Take out 'Sorting The Clothes By Seasons' Activity Sheet. Cut along the dotted lines to get separate pictures.

Step 2

Talk about the different seasons and the months they fall in. Discuss how the weather is during each season and what kind of clothes are suitable for each season.

Step 3

Let your child sort the clothes according to the seasons they are worn in and glue them in the correct columns

Activity Intro: All living things need air to survive. Here's a worksheet for your little one to solve and classify the things that can't live without air.


Material Required

Step 1


Circle the objects that feel hot or cold, hard or soft when touched.




The Sense Of Touch




Colour the objects that are :- Hot-Red, Cold-Blue Soft-Yellow, Hard-Brown.




























NAME OF ACTIVITY The Grand Old Duke Of York-Ascending & Descending
