





Step 1


Print out the train craft worksheet and the train craft printable. Cut along the dotted lines to get separate carriages and the engine.

Help your child to glue the engine, the carriages and the wheels on the worksheet to complete the train.





Train Craft

NAME OF ACTIVITY- **DOG BONE COUNTING**

Ask your child to count and place the correct number of bones in the bowl to match the number on the bowl.

Step 3

Continue the activity with all the other numbers.




Dog Bone Counting Mat

NAME OF ACTIVITY- **FISHING THE COLOURS**

Activity Intro- Colour, it's one of the most noticeable attributes of the world around us. To develop a blend of thinking skills, fine motor skills and the concept of magnetism in your child with the help of colours, make use of this activity.

So let the fun begin!

Activity Aims Tag- Fine motor development, Thinking skills, Colours, Understanding magnetism.

Material Required

- Activity Sheets
- Poster Colours: red, yellow, blue & green
- Paper Clips: 16
- A small stick about 8 to 10 inches long
- Twine
- Magnets
- A Big Tray
- Blue Cloth / Paper, to place it in the tray

STEPS:

Step 1

Print out the fish printable sheets.

Step 2

Cut along the dotted lines to get separate fish cut-outs.

Step 3

Tie a twine to one end of the stick to make the fishing rod.

Step 4

At the other end of the twine tie a magnet. The fishing rod is ready to use. The magnet will attract the paper clip on the fish.

Step 5

Place a blue cloth or paper on the tray. Arrange the coloured fish on the tray. Let your child use the fishing rod to catch a fish.

Step 6






Play the game until your child fishes out all the fishes.







Fishing The Colours Printable








NAME OF ACTIVITY- **PATTERN GRID GAME**

Step 3


Give your child the pattern mat. Ask your child to observe the pattern. Help your child to complete the pattern by placing the correct counters in the grids.
