- Preferential use of recycled and recyclable materials
- Green Dot

REDUCIR

Saving resources and creating the minimum amount of waste so we contaminate as little as possible:

- Water consumption
- Electricity consumption
- Raw material consumption
- Gas consumption





RECUPERAR

Applying processes to waste in order to generate energy or obtain raw materials:

- Glass, cans, etc.
- Cardboard







We include km0 products from local producers in our breakfast options, including: Zalla bread, curd, quince and fresh cheese from Santi (Trapaga), Maikala pastries, Idiazabal cheese, Ordizia cheese, Kaiku guince, yoghurts and milk, and local fruit.

In order to generate less waste and have the lowest environmental impact possible, we don't use single-use plastic in our kitchenware.

Micro-filtered water allows us to avoid having to transport and package water, meaning we contaminate less, save energy and reduce PET plastic consumption.

VEGETARIAN/VEGAN OPTIONS

Our clients are offered a wide range of vegan and vegetarian menus and dishes. This is all in the interest of environmentally friendly, sustainable consumption and society's growing awareness in this area.





Water consumption management


- We avoid washing fruit and vegetables under the tap.
- We've installed pressurised water devices on our taps.

Energy consumption management

- We cook using appropriately sized pans.
- We don't overfill saucepans.
- We clean ovens and hobs frequently.
- We cover pans.
- We switch off kitchen appliances, such as extractor fans, when they aren't in use.
- We set the dishwasher to a temperature that isn't too high.
- We do not put hot food inside refrigerators.
- We use the dishwasher and other electrical appliances with full loads.
- We make full use of natural light in restaurants and bars.

Waste management

- We avoid using products with lots of packaging: the less packaging, the better.
- We separate glass, paper, packaging and organic waste for recycling.
- We avoid using paper napkins and tablecloths.
- We reuse empty packaging whenever possible.
- We've installed grates in basins to prevent waste from blocking the general network.







We reduce plastic waste and we also make full use of personal hygiene products.

WATER-SAVING FILTER IN SHOWERS

This way, the water saved with each shower is XX litres, or XYZ litres each year.

ROOM LIGHTS ARE ONLY CONNECTED USING THE ROOM KEY

Every time a guest leaves their room, all lights are disconnected to encourage energy saving and avoid forgetfulness.

CHANGE OF SHEETS AND TOWELS ONLY WHEN REQUESTED BY THE GUEST

As a result, we avoid unnecessary washing of bed and bathroom linen, saving water and energy.

ROOM ONLY MADE UP WHEN REQUESTED BY THE GUEST

This helps us reduce the consumption of cleaning products, etc.

LED LIGHTS THROUGHOUT THE FACILITIES

We've installed LED lights, enabling us to make savings on energy consumption.

HEATING AND AIR CONDITIONING IN COMMUNAL AREAS IN COMPLIANCE WITH REGULATIONS
