

COVID-19 information to access the Hotel

1- Health requirements for passengers entering the Autonomous Community of the Canary Islands from the rest of Spain by air or sea.

It is sufficient to meet one of the following requirements:

- Antigen test with negative result carried out less than 72 hours prior to arrival at the establishment.
- Complete vaccination certificate:
- Certificate of the first dose received more than 15 days prior to arrival at the hotel.
- Medical certificate by the competent authority or by a medical service within the last 6 months.

2- Canary Island Resident:

- Any of the above requirements for peninsular passengers.
- Responsible declaration of not having left the archipelago in the last 15 days, to be filled in at the hotel.

3- Travelling to Spain from a country of the EU or European Economic Area (EEA) One of these three requirements must be fulfilled:

- **Vaccination certificate:** issued by the competent authorities of the country of origin 14 days after the date of administration of the last dose of the complete vaccination schedule.
- **Diagnostic certificate:** Negative test (PCR) or similar (NAAT type) or negative antigen test, issued within 48 hours prior to arrival in Spain.
- **Certificate of recovery (proof that the disease has been overcome).** Issued by the competent authority or by a medical service at least 11 days after the first positive diagnostic test. The validity of the certificate will end 180 days from the date of taking the sample.

4- Travel to Spain for tourism from a country that does not belong to the European Union or the European Economic Area

You will need to consult LIST OF EUROPEAN UNION/ EUROPEAN ECONOMIC AREA COUNTRIES and LIST OF THIRD COUNTRIES) to check:

1 - If you are travelling from a country or territory included in the list of low incidence countries, excluded from the risk zone you can travel without diagnostic test or certificate of vaccination or immunity. Currently the countries included on this list are:

Australia

- . Israel
- . Japan
- . New Zealand
- . Rwanda
- . Singapore
- . South Korea
- . Thailand
- . United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland
- . China and the special administrative regions of Hong Kong and Macao

2 - If you are travelling from a country or territory that is not on the list of exempted countries as of 7 June, persons travelling for tourism will be allowed entry if they have a certificate of vaccination issued by the competent authorities of the country of origin from 14 days after the date of administration of the last dose required to complete the course of vaccination.
