VISIT LA CALA DE MIJAS

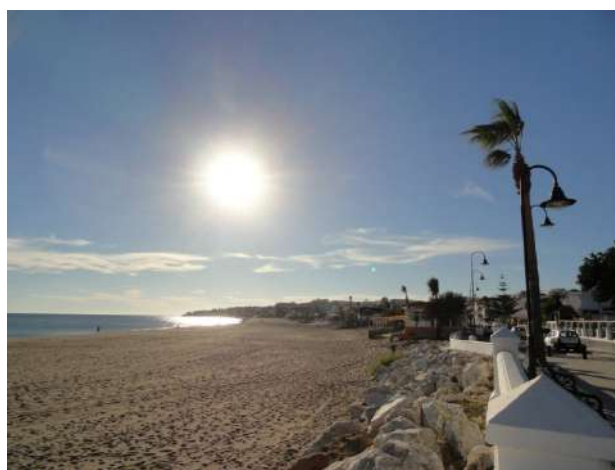


This beautiful town of agricultural and fishing origin is located 500 meters away from Torrenueva Park. Discover the charm of its old town with its white houses. You can visit the Interpretation Center of the Torres Vigías and know its origin, dating from the sixteenth century. We recommend that you take a look at Reception to the top 10 best things to do in La Cala de Mijas. For example, a selfie with the Burro-Taxi Monument at the Boulevard!

The seabed from El Faro to Calahonda is classified as a Special Conservation Area. Here

the Mediterranean Ocean meets the Atlantic, creating a unique fauna and flora, such as the oceanic Posidonia. Take a walk on its beaches or dive and discover it!

Visit the Street Market in the Fairgrounds on Wednesday and Saturday mornings. You can buy from seasonal fruit and vegetables, to clothing, typical crafts like ceramic and wicker pieces...

THE CHARMING WHITE VILLAGES: MIJAS PUEBLO



Visit Mijas Pueblo and discover the charm of its white houses in contrast to the green of the pines offering one of the most beautiful pictures of the coast.

Get to know the Burro-Taxis, the tiny and irregularly shaped Plaza de Toros; the remains of the old Arab wall in which are enclaved some beautiful gardens and the interesting sanctuary of the Virgen de la Peña, as well as the Church of the Immaculate Conception and the Hermitage of Calvary. Browse the craft shops and discover why Mijas is a specialist in wicker and ceramics. In Reception you can find free maps and more information.



Mijas Pueblo also offers visitors interesting museums: El Carromato de Mijas (miniature collection), the Flour Mill, the House Museum of the Villa (historical-ethnological museum) and the Contemporary Art Center (CAC Mijas). We suggest you visit Mayan Monkey Mijas, the award-winning chocolate factory and museum: ask for information at reception.

MARBELLA, A CITY FULL OF DREAMS

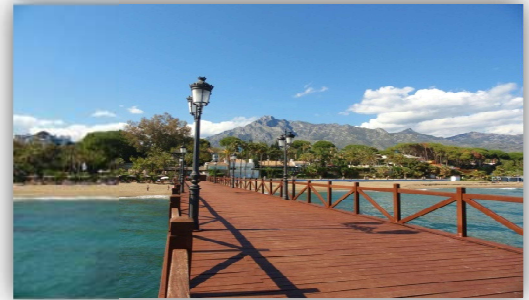

Visit La Cañada Commercial Park, more than 100,000 square meters that houses the best national and international firms, as well as restaurants, leisure areas ... And if not, you can visit the Street Market on Monday mornings.

Know the Coastal Footpath Dunes of Artola, formed by the union of wind. Its most famous beach is Cabopino, where you can enjoy the experience of taking a swim in the sea on sandbars, and also, get to know Ladrones Tower, the highest Watch Tower of the Malaga coastline. In addition, here is one of the two nudist beaches of Malaga.

Also, in Elviria, we suggest you not miss Amazonia Adventure, an adventure park in the trees to enjoy with friends or family. With the longest zip line in Andalusia! Ask at reception for your discounted entrance.

Visit Puerto Banús, the leading luxury marina in Europe. Discover luxury vehicles and boats, as well as the most sought-after fashion boutiques such as Gucci, Dior, Valentino, Louis Vuitton ... And last but not least, you can also visit the Marina Banús Shopping Center. In addition, this area is a reference for nightlife: visit elegant venues such as Linekers, Funky Buddha, Tibu, Pangea or Aqua.

FUENGIROLA, A SUN OF CITY



This city attracted and left amazed how many civilizations came to these coasts: Phoenicians, Romans, Arabs ..., leaving traces of their culture that can still be appreciated, such as the famous ruins of Sohail Castle, built in the 10th century by the Arabs and located at the mouth of the Fuengirola River, where you can also take a walk through its Fluvial Park and enjoy numerous outdoor activities, such as the Multiadventure Castillo Sohail.

In addition, next to it, the Miramar Shopping Center is located, with more than 160 establishments that house important fashion firms, restaurants, leisure areas such as a cinema and karting. And if not, you can visit the Mercadillo on Tuesdays and Sundays in the morning.

This city is full of leisure, here are some suggestions. You can ask at Reception for availability and price of the activities that we recommend:

- Enjoy visiting Bioparc, a unique zoo where animals live together in a recreation of their natural habitat, such as the thick forests of Madagascar, Asia or the Pacific Islands.

- Visit its marina and perform nautical activities such as diving, paddle surfing or even dolphin watching. You can even catch a ferry to Benalmádena! Nearby, there is the Mijas Aquatic Park, true fun in the water.

Something that certainly can not be missed, is Finca Cartujano: your bus will pick you up next to Torrenueva Park, and you can enjoy a barbecue dinner and a real flamenco show and equestrian art with more than 15 spectacular Spanish horses.

TORREMOLINOS, A MODERN CITY OF MARINE TRADITION



Pioneer in tourism with its cosmopolitan and multicultural environment, with day and night leisure insured for all ages.

Stroll along its Coastal Footpath and discover its best beaches and cliffs; know the Torre Pimentel, built more than 700 years ago by the Catholic Monarchs; the singular Casa de los Navajas; tour the lungs of the city, the Battery Park; discover El Morro, a natural monument visible from any point of the coast of Torremolinos.

Go shopping to the famous Calle San Miguel, whose specialized businesses in handicrafts coexist with large fashion, footwear, jewelry and souvenir firms. If not, you can visit its Street Market on Thursday morning. Get to know the popular beach clubs of La Carihuela or Los Alamos and lie down in a Balinese bed, relax with the chill out, savor a cocktail and surrender to the sunset of the coast.

And if you like nightlife, visit La Nogalera: its square and adjacent streets have a wide commercial, gastronomic and leisure offer, which is complemented by the Pueblo Blanco area. It is a reference for LGBTI tourism, with many bars and clubs.

We suggest activities, Aqualand Torremolinos, a world of water and fun to go with family or friends. Right next door you can visit Cocodile Park, and catch a baby crocodile! You can also visit El Ranchito, the famous equestrian club, and enjoy a flamenco and equestrian show, a welcome drink and a dinner.

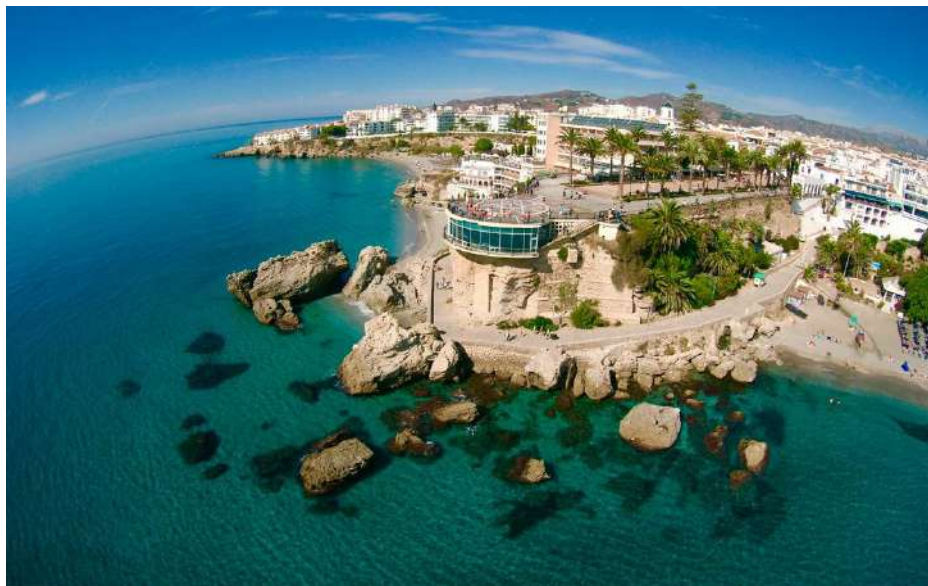
If you want to go shopping, visit Plaza Mayor, the largest open-air shopping park in Andalusia, with a wide range of fashion, restaurants and leisure.

RONDA, DREAMED CITY

It is one of the oldest cities in Spain. Stroll through its streets and feel like in a movie thanks to its architecture. Churches, houses like palaces ... The New Bridge, which is, together with the Bullring of the Real Maestranza de Caballería de Ronda, the symbol and soul of the city ... Discover the Archaeological Site of Acinipo or the Baths Arabs and contemplate more than 3,000 years of history. Ask at reception to book your excursion!

ENJOY ANTEQUERA

Antequera owes its name to the word of Iberian origin Antikaria, which means "in front of the great calcareous mass", because the city is opposite the famous Torcal, one of the most impressive examples of karstic landscape in Europe, a place unique natural, declared a World Heritage Site by Unesco.

With more than six thousand years of history, visit the famous Dolmens, spectacular for its magnificent state of preservation.



Discover the Chorro Reservoir and fall in love with its forests, its waters, its paths and viewpoints, its ravines and its boxed rivers, as well as its great sports offer.

You can not miss El Caminito del Rey, a pedestrian walkway of more than 3 kilometers attached to the rock inside a canyon, with sections of a width of just 1 meter, hanging up to 105 meters above the river, in almost vertical walls. Ask at reception for your entrance and discover one of the most beautiful places in Spain!
