Business Purpose	 Violation of HIPAA privacy practices can result in heavy fines and prison terms. This training aims to decrease the number of HIPAA violations that occur at Hospital X by 50%. To do so, this course will describe HIPAA privacy policy and provide opportunities for the learner to practice responding to situations that commonly lead to HIPAA violations.
	 The most common HIPAA violation is failure to ensure patient privacy and to protect personal health information (PHI). This training will increase patient privacy and protection of PHI by outlining the protocols that are in place to do so.
	 To increase the awareness of Hospital X's Notice of Privacy Policies, which describes the responsibilities of healthcare workers with respect to HIPAA.
Target Audience	• Current and new employees of Hospital X who work with personal health information.
Training Time	• 20-30 minutes
Training Recommendation	 One e-Learning course as part of the onboarding process for new employees, and part of a yearly refresher course for current employees of Hospital X.
	 An asynchronous, e-Learning course is the most appropriate modality given the large number of employees at Hospital X who work with PHI. In addition, employees requiring the training have different daily and weekly schedules, making synchronous training difficult.
	 This e-Learning will follow a host character who is a health care worker at the hospital.
	 This employee will provide information to the learner on how to keep patient information secure and will encounter various situations in which HIPAA regulations need to be remembered and/or applied.
