- Based on the rapid growth of Ernst Inc., 2000 new members of the technical team need to be recruited and hired this year.
- The current interviewing process is not resulting in the quality or quantity of hires Ernst Inc. is looking for. 35% of newly hired technical team members leave the company within the first year. The company believes that a strategy in which interview best practices are used will result in the hiring of the top candidates.
- Upon completion of this training, hiring managers will implement interviewing best practices to hire 2000 quality technical team members. As a result, technical team attrition will drop to no more than 5% within the first year.

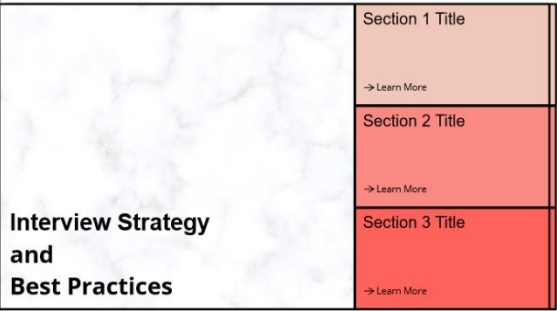

<p>Strong candidates are very likely to have other interviews and opportunities available. It is important to show the candidate that we respect their time. ## Effective Interview Strategies - Storyboard

<p>[OST 1] Schedule the interview in a timely manner. Delaying the interview process puts our company at risk to lose strong candidates. Be sure to schedule the interview for the earliest possible time.</p> <p>[OST 2] Arrive early for the interview. By doing so, you can have the space prepared for the candidate before the interview begins.</p> <p>[OST 3] Keep the interview on track. Without rushing the interview, be mindful of the time. Often the candidate has taken time off from work to interview with us, or has other people in the company to meet. Interviews that take up more than the scheduled time may delay those meetings</p>

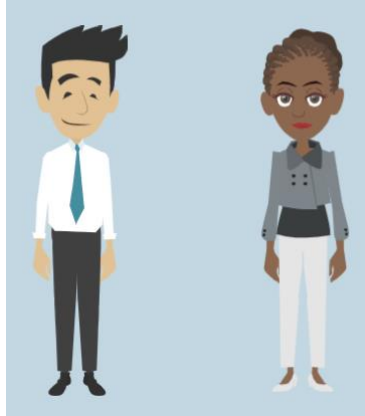

This ensures that you can ask appropriate questions and assess the quality of responses with respect to the position.</p> <p>[OST 1] Determine the major topics to focus on during the interview. By doing so, you are more likely to ask relevant questions that align with the position</p> <p>[OST 2] Decide which questions you will ask and the order in which you will ask them. Having prepared questions shows the candidate we are seriously considering them for the position. It is also important to have a logical order to the questions so you can eliminate redundancy that may occur based on the candidate's answers</p> <p>[OST 3] There may be times when a candidate says something that makes you want to know more. <p><b>Slide 1.4 Layer 3, Focus on the Purpose of the Interview</b></p>			
<p>[OST 1] It is important to fully understand the requirements of the position to decide if a candidate is the right match</p> <p>[OST 2] Focus on the candidate and really listen to their responses and questions. Your body language and behaviour is important – the candidate needs to know that you are really hearing what they have to say</p> <p>[OST 3] The purpose of the interview is to ascertain the candidate's ability to fulfill the role to your satisfaction. While it may be tempting to talk about your qualifications, the conversation is about the candidate.</p>	<p><b>Title: Focus on the Purpose of the Interview</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1.
