# MICROSOFT TEAMS PHONE SYSTEM

## PURPOSE

This job aid defines the Teams Phone System, lists its requirements, and provides Teams Phone System with Calling Plan set up instructions for both users and auto attendants.

## TEAMS PHONE SYSTEM

The Teams Phone System is a cloud-based system in which Teams replaces an organization's phone system. With this system, both internal and external calls can be made and received through Teams on multiple devices.

## PUBLIC SWITCHED TELEPHONE NETWORK (PSTN) CONNECTIVITY OPTIONS

There are several options available:

- ▶ **Calling Plan:** Microsoft becomes the PSTN carrier and service provider.
- ▶ **Operator Connect:** The existing carrier manages the PSTN services but must participate in the Microsoft Operator Connect program.
- ▶ **Teams Phone Mobile:** A user's SIM-enabled phone number is also their Teams phone number.
- ▶ **Direct Routing:** Organizations can choose their own PSTN carrier but gives the organization the option to manage and configure it.

## LICENSING REQUIREMENTS: TEAMS PHONE SYSTEM WITH CALLING PLAN

Both the Teams Phone System license and the Calling Plan license are required. A Resource Account license is also required to make use of the auto attendant and call queue features.

## USER SET UP
