


What are YOU willing to do for change?

The Expectations from All Sides

Students:

- Expect to be redirected when your behavior or word usage has the potential to cause danger or chaos
- Expect adults to address you with respect at all times, even if they see a need to use a "louder" voice
- Expect staff to direct you onto the buses to help you get home safely as soon as possible
- Expect consequences if you choose to disrespect an adult who is trying to ensure your

Adults:

- Expect students to mimic your behavior /word usage; therefore if you are passive, aggressive, or over the top, they will be too
- Expect to mingle with students and be an everyday consistent presence to build trust and respect
- Expect to hold other adults accountable for their equal roles and responsibilities
- Expect phone calls and details for when any problems arise with a student that needs to be rectified or restored
