Forming the Nominations Panel for CGIAR's Independent Science for Development Council (ISDC) members

<u>Purpose</u>: This document identifies the proposed five members of the 2019 ISDC Nominations Panel, to take forward the nominations process for the ISDC member vacancies arising in 2019.

As additional background resources, this document also provides in respectively numbered Annexes: (I) a recap of the appointment process for ISDC members as set out in the ISDC TOR; (II) the decisions already taken by the System Council with regard to the 2019 ISDC appointment process; and (III) background information on the 2019 ISDC membership transition.

Action Requested: Pursuant to paragraph 4.4 of the ISDC Terms of Reference, the System Council is requested to consider, and

if thought appropriate, <u>approve</u> the five persons set out in this presentation to serve as members of the 2019 ISDC Member Nominations Panel, such persons to serve in their individual capacities, and pursuant to Article 3.5 of the CGIAR System Framework, in good faith in the interests of the CGIAR System.

Annex I. Recap from ISDC terms of reference (approved 4 October 2018)



Appointment process:

- ISDC members, including the ISDC Chair, are appointed by the System Council based upon a merit-based, open and competitive selection process that includes the following elements:
 - A broad call for applications and nominations, including a visible public element as part of that call;
 - Review and consideration of applications and nominations by <u>a nominations panel</u> comprised of up to six (6) persons from the following groups as <u>chaired</u> by the <u>SIMEC Chair</u>:

At least two <u>System</u>
<u>Council members</u>
<u>nominated by the System</u>
<u>Council Chair</u>, one of whom shall be the SIMEC Chair or her/his delegate



Up to two science leaders nominated by the System Council Chair, one involved in the delivery of research outputs in a development context and one other individual associated with major science bodies working across a range of disciplines



Up to two persons fully external to CGIAR, with a preference for at least one of those persons to be a highly experienced individual involved in innovation from a sector beyond agriculture.

- The terms of reference for the nominations panel, including membership, will be approved by the System Council through electronic means. The membership of the nominations panel will be diverse and demonstrate CGIAR's strong commitment to ensuring gender equality in all facets of its work. The nominations panel will be permitted to seek the views of the Chair of the ISDC during the screening process for new ISDC members, but the ISDC Chair will not personally serve on the nominations panel.
- The search and nominations process will be undertaken according to the administrative policies of the CGIAR System Organization and be managed by the System Management Office under the overall oversight of the nominations panel. For the avoidance of doubt, the CGIAR System Organization has no decision-making role in regard to the selection of ISDC members.

ISDC member replenishment status

Proceeding according to System Council no-objection electronic decision effective on 9 April 2019

- 3 June 2019: Deadline for applications/nominations for ISDC Chair and 5 member roles
- Early-mid June 2019: Screening against agreed criteria of applications/nominations to form shortlist
- Late-June through July: Nominations Panel to interview and undertake reference checks
- By 12 August 2019: Recommended ISDC Chair and member vacancies submitted to SC for no-objection electronic approval
- **Anticipated 1 September 2019**: Member start dates
