

System Board and Committee 2021 Planning

<u>Purpose</u>: This document sets out considerations on System Board planning, including a proposed approach to 2021 Center/Alliance Board meetings, aligned to key One CGIAR deliverables.





1. CGIAR Board Planning – The aspiration

- 5 Board meetings per year with all One CGIAR Boards participating as appropriate
- Each meeting focused on thematic areas, including, for example:
 - February past year performance and EMT and DG assessments
 - May financial and investment reviews and approving audited financials
 - <u>July</u> funding portfolio and meeting with funders
 - <u>September</u> planning for the next year
 - November approve budgets and plans for the next year
- A common committee structure for science and assurance oversight

2. A pragmatic approach as we start 2021

Center/Alliance Boards and System Board meetings



Recognizing that key workstreams to enable this (such as work on common committees) are continuing and that we are still building momentum and 'good will' among Center/Alliance Board membership that would allow a more significant shift in how Boards operate. The proposed approach aims to keep the next round of meetings as streamlined as possible.

Center/Alliance Boards

3-week window (weeks of 26 April, 3 May, 10 May)

- One Center Board meeting each day on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday
- To ensure quorum 6 of 8 voting members
 required to be in attendance at each session

Program Committees

- Continue for 2021 current Center level Program Committee/Advisory structures (to continue oversight of current Research Portfolio to end-2021)
- As Investment Plan is developed, appropriate streamlined oversight mechanisms to be developed on a collaborative basis, to commence from 2022

Audit and Risk Committees

- Audit Committee Chairs group to meet in coming weeks to agree approach/timeline for work towards a common Audit & Risk Committee (continuing the early work of TAG-3)
- Pending those discussions, existing Center Audit Committee structure will likely continue through the Q2 Center Board meetings and would be responsible for review and recommendation of the 2020 audited financial statements before the Center meeting window dates as proposed above
- Noting that there is now considerably more common membership among CGIAR'S audit committees, planning will be coordinated, aligned to the Board meeting dates



3. Out of session matters and other Board engagement

Coordinated out of session decision-making

For 2021 we will strive for coordinated communication, particularly on like matters, strategically using Diligent Boards. An example of this is the expected decision request on Center 2021 Programs of Work and Budget in January.

Other Board engagement

Induction of a new System Board member

The System Board voting member vacancy is anticipated to be filled in Q1 2021. The Common Secretariat will put in place an induction program, which is anticipated to involve some informal engagement among the System Board members

'Champion' and representation roles

System Board members also play highly-valued roles in support of key CGIAR priorities, including but not limited to the Gender Champions and the Resource Mobilization, Communications and Advocacy action area champions
