

Report from the Strategic Impact, Monitoring & Evaluation Committee (SIMEC)

<u>Purpose</u>: **For information**: This document sets out an overview of SIMEC's activities and areas of focus on its under its mandate since the System Council's last meeting in June 2021.



Supporting System Council's consideration of the 2022-2024 Investment Prospectus



- During the System Council's 13th meeting ('SC13') the ISDC was asked to provide <u>advice to the System Council on the coherence of the 2022-2024 Investment Prospectus</u>.
- SIMEC held two ad hoc calls (5 August and 30 August 2021), during which it considered what is meant by coherence and how this ask should be translated into a Terms of Reference for ISDC's review.
- Based on these inputs, a TOR was prepared under the guidance of the SIMEC Chair, in consultation with the EMT, SIMEC Secretary and Director, CGIAR Advisory Services Shared Secretariat – and endorsed by SIMEC before being shared with the ISDC and System Council on 21 September 2021.

SIMEC role from its TOR

Para 2: Advise and make recommendations to the System Council related to the System Council's:

a. [...] approving System-level strategic priorities.

CGIAR Performance and Results Management Framework ('PRMF')



- Discussion on PRMF at two SIMEC meetings:
 - SIMEC22 (20 September 2021) Update on implementation – including <u>support provided to</u> <u>Initiative Design Teams</u> on theory of change, innovation packages and scaling readiness, projected benefits and impact assessment.
 - SIMEC23 (24 November 2021) Discussion on CGIAR Results Framework & <u>Reporting Arrangement</u> <u>including planned timeline for delivery</u> over 2022
- Guidance from SIMEC included emphasis on the value of opportunities to <u>explore how the PRMF interacts with</u> <u>CGIAR's Advisory Services</u> and thus supports the overall performance of CGIAR's portfolio

SIMEC role from its TOR

Para 5: Advise and make recommendations to the System Council related to the System Council's:

- **a.** Oversight of CGIAR's performance indicators methodology and targets; [...]
- **c.** Review and approval of an integrated framework for a performance management system for CGIAR Research

CGIAR Advisory Services Multi-Year Workplans and Budgets



- **Guidance from SIMEC** provided in SIMEC22 meeting on:
 - <u>Evaluation priorities</u> for the 2022-2024 cycle and guidance on approach to evaluations
 - <u>Priorities for impact assessment</u> in the second phase of a '3+3' workplan –
 including ensuring continuity for activities delayed by Covid-19 and continuing
 reflection on how SPIA's work should complement and align with the PRMF
 - ISDC's proposed workplan priorities including comparative advantage and innovation, and support for a review of ISDC's ToR to ensure it algins with the One CGIAR operating reality
- Further inputs provided electronically on draft workplans and budgets, noting that oversight of entity budgets is undertaken by the System Council's Assurance Oversight Committee ('AOC') as well as in the CGIAR Audit, Finance and Risk Committee's review of the overall 2022-2204 FINPLAN

<u>Recommendation to the System Council</u>: SIMEC <u>endorses</u> the CGIAR Advisory Services 2022-2024 Workplans and Budgets

SIMEC role from its TOR

Para 5: Advise and make recommendations to the System Council related to the System Council's:

d. Review and approval of relevant System entities' work programs and budgets





Evaluation

- During SIMEC23 Strong support for <u>Evaluation Report on Big Data Platform</u>
- Request made that the System Council consider this and a management response (to be developed) at its next meeting
- Evaluation of the Excellence in Breeding (EiB) Platform in progress
 TOR shared for SIMEC review/input in August 2021

Embedding Impact Assessment

- SIMEC ad hoc call on 30 August 2021 Discussion with SPIA Chair
- On <u>importance of ensuring that robust impact assessment plans</u> are built into <u>Initiative research design</u>
- Outcome guidance given to EMT and IDTs as Initiative proposals being developed and finalized

SIMEC role from its TOR

Para 6: Advise and make recommendations to the System Council related to the System Council's:

- **a**. Approval of a cost-effective multi-year evaluation plan [...]
- **b**. Review and endorsement of [...] evaluations of the CGIAR Portfolio

CGIAR Evaluation Policy and Framework



- In May/June 2021 approach to revision of <u>CGIAR Policy</u> for <u>Independent External Evaluation</u> (2012) shared during 'deep-dive' session ahead of SC13 meeting
- At SIMEC23 (24November 2021) SIMEC reviewed and provided guidance on a draft CGIAR Evaluation Policy and Framework
- Support for the developing Policy and Framework and consultation undertaken, with the ask that its finalization be undertaken as a 'co-design/co-presentation' with the EMT
- Request that final version be presented for System Council approval at March 2022 meeting

SIMEC role from its TOR

Para 4: Advise and make recommendations to the System Council related to the System Council's approval of CGIAR Policies related to strategic impact, monitoring and/or evaluation that are critical to maintaining the reputation of the CGIAR System.





Looking ahead to 2022

Role of SIMEC

- SIMECTOR was approved in May 2017

 there have been a number of changes
 in the context since that time
- Planned <u>review of SIMEC's role and</u> <u>composition</u> in context of System Council oversight needs
 - In coordination with the AOC
 - Considering programmatic and assurance oversight arrangements being considered by the System Board

Workplan focus areas

- Continued focus on delivery and implementation of CGIAR Results
 Framework – and its complementarity with roles of Advisory Services
- Final CGIAR Evaluation Policy and Framework
- Planned assessments of CGIAR's advisory services as required by their respective TORs
