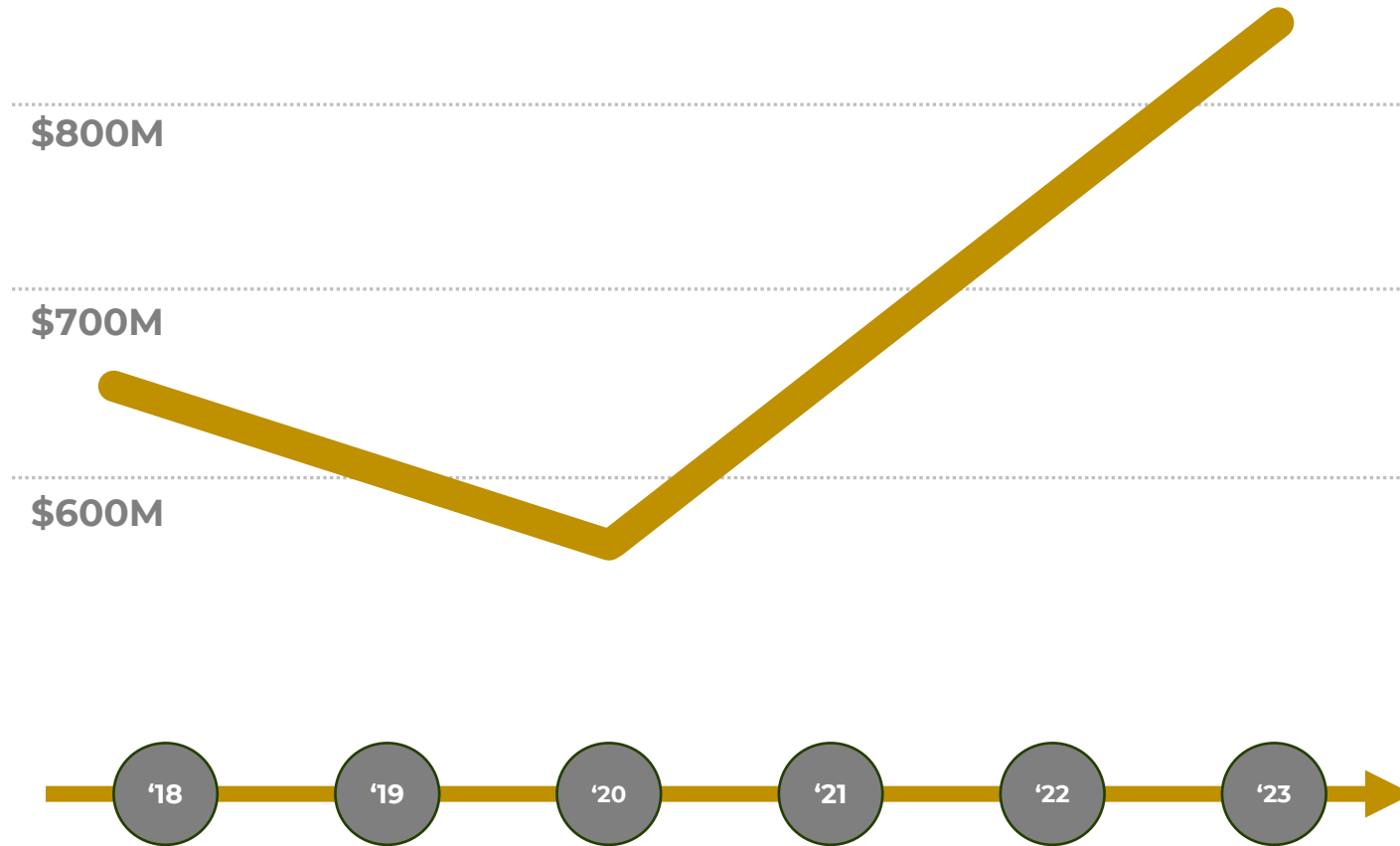


Prioritize Pooled Funding for One CGIAR



- CGIAR funding has rebounded since Covid dip
- Pooled funding increased from \$160M 2018-20 to \$310M+ today
- Pooled funding grew from 21% to 34% - with limited impact on Bilateral.

Growth from current and new sources

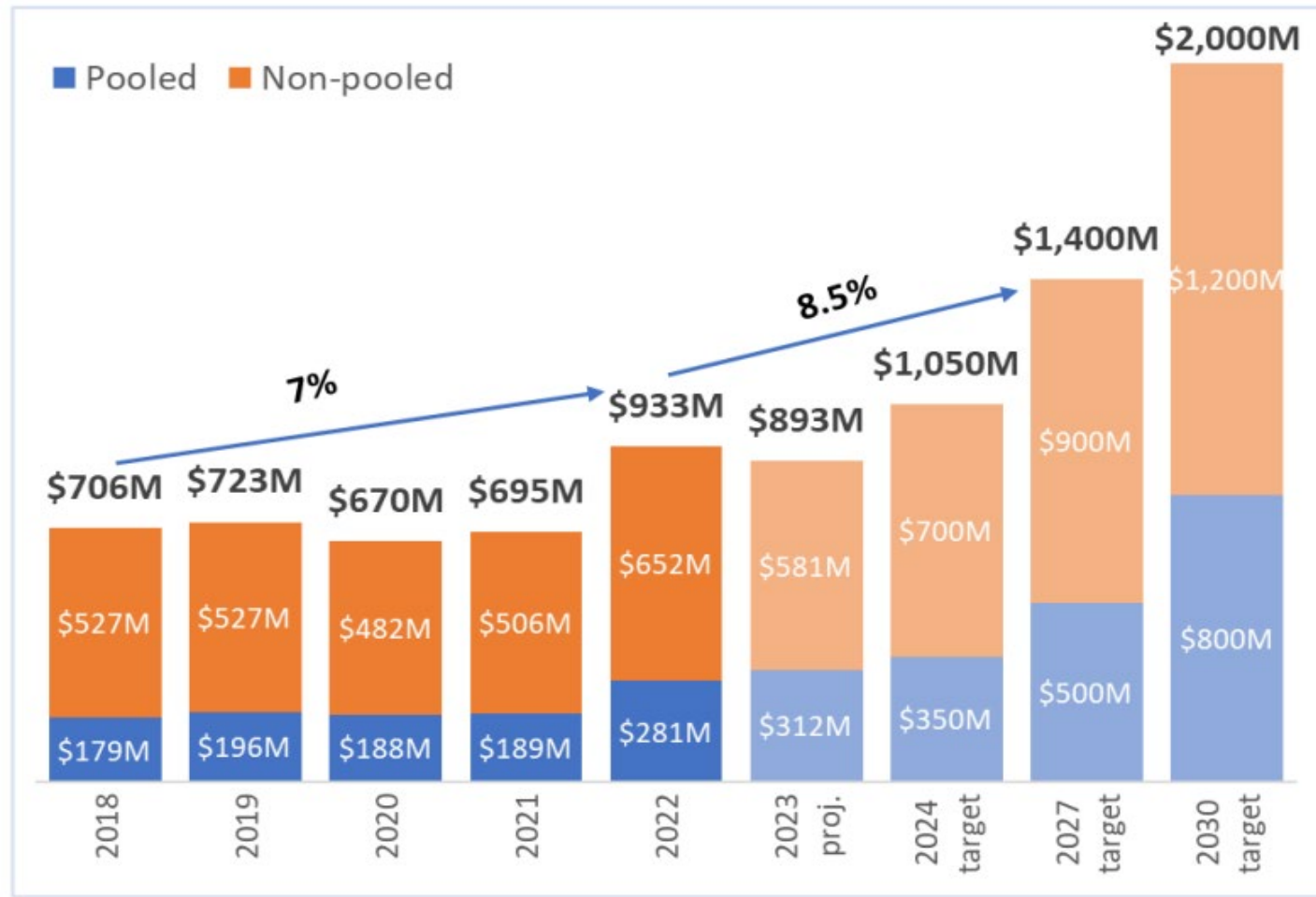


Figure 1: Funds raised for One CGIAR in US\$ for 2018-2022, projections for 2023 and targets to 2030

- Since 2018, funds raised for CGIAR has grown at an average of 7%.
- To reach \$1.4B by 2027 rates need to increase to 8.5%-10% year on year.
- Sustained growth needed to reach \$2B by 2030.
- Growth targets both current and new sources.
