Godly Play way of Dwelling in the Word Luke 10:1-12 (NRSV)

Place figure of Jesus on the underlay to your immediate left.



perspective

As you begin **slowly** 'walk' pair 1 of the disciples to a town (represented by a dot).

'Walk pair 2 of disciples to a 'town'...

... followed by pair 3.
(Don't rush).

As you say 'see, I am sending...' walk a pair of lambs to a town, followed by another pair of lambs.

Place the wolves nearby.

After this Jesus chose seventy others and sent them on ahead of him in pairs to every town and place where he himself intended to go.

He said to them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the labourers are few; therefore ask the Lord of the harvest to send out labourers into his harvest.

Go on your way. See, I am sending you out like lambs into the midst of wolves.

Walk pair 4 of disciples to another 'town'.

Carry no purse, no bag, no sandals; and greet no one on the road.

'....if anyone is there who shares in peace..' Bring a dove in front the disciples and place it down as you say 'your peace will rest on that person'. Add 5 more doves to other towns where you have placed disciples.

Whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this house!' And if anyone is there who shares in peace, your peace will rest on that person;

'but if not...' take the dove back, hold it to the front of the disciples and put it away.

but if not, it will return to you.

Walk pair of disciples 5 to a town.

Remain in the same house, eating and drinking whatever they provide, for the labourer deserves to be paid. Do not move about from house to house.

When you say 'The
Kingdom of God has come
near, make a 'blessing

Whenever you enter a town and its people welcome you, eat what is set before you; cure the sick who are there, and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.'

action' (hold flat hand) over the disciples and the town'

On 'but whenever...' add & remove a dove (as earlier).

But whenever you enter a town and they do not welcome you, go out into its streets and say,

wipe off in protest against you.

'Even the dust'

'Even the dust of your town that clings to our feet, we

Forcefully clean hands
(wipe palm with palm to
'wipe dust from them').

Yet know this: the kingdom of God has come near.'

On 'Yet know this: the
Kingdom of God as come
near', again make the
blessing action.

I tell you, on that day it will be more tolerable for Sodom than for that town.
