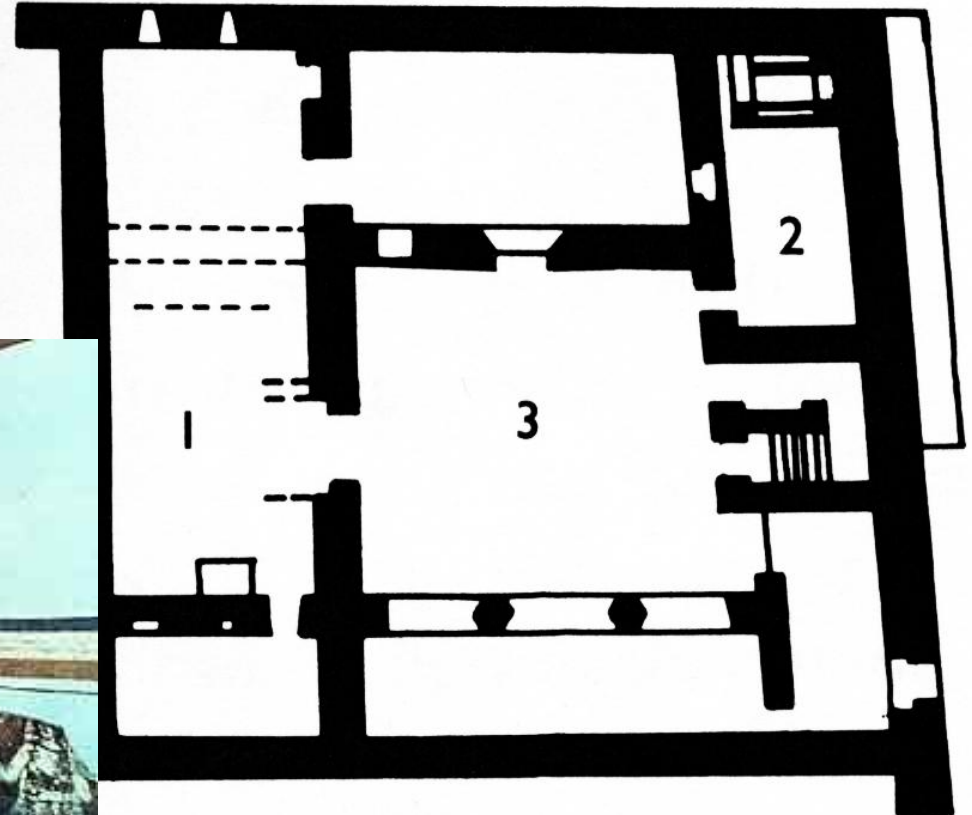




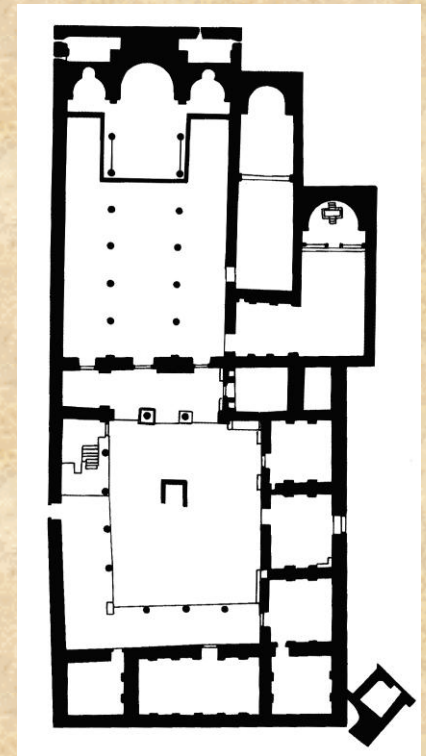
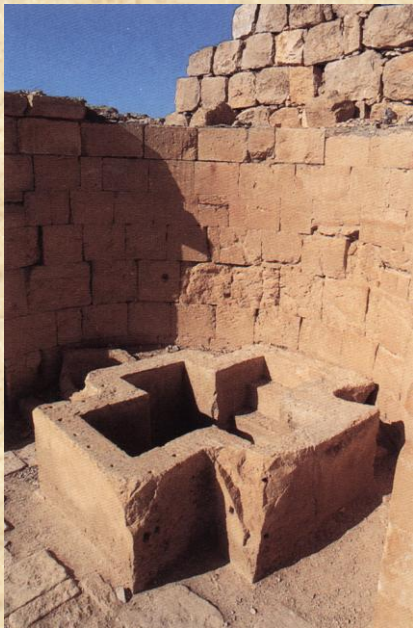
DOMESTIC CHURCH

3. Open courtyard

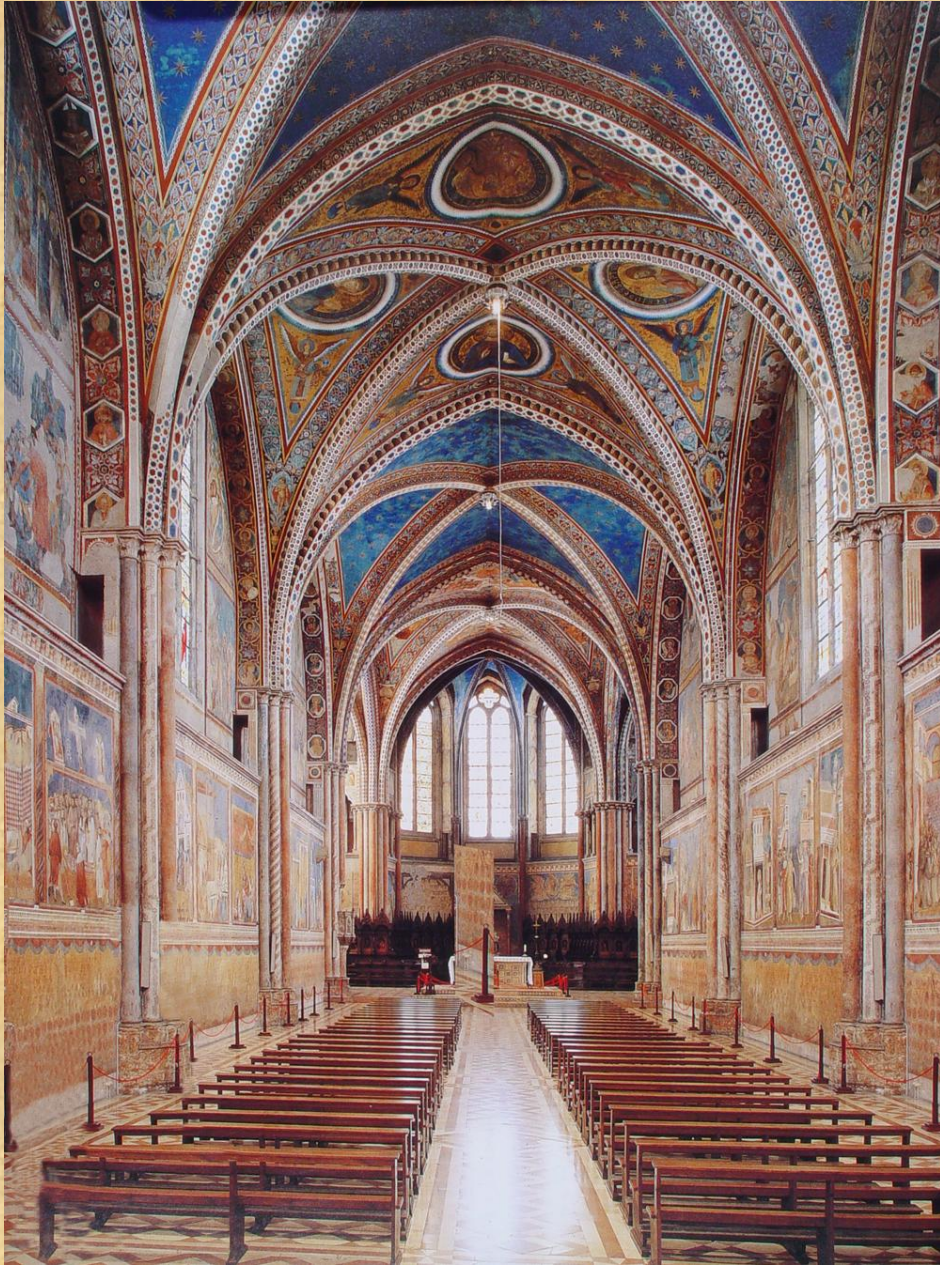

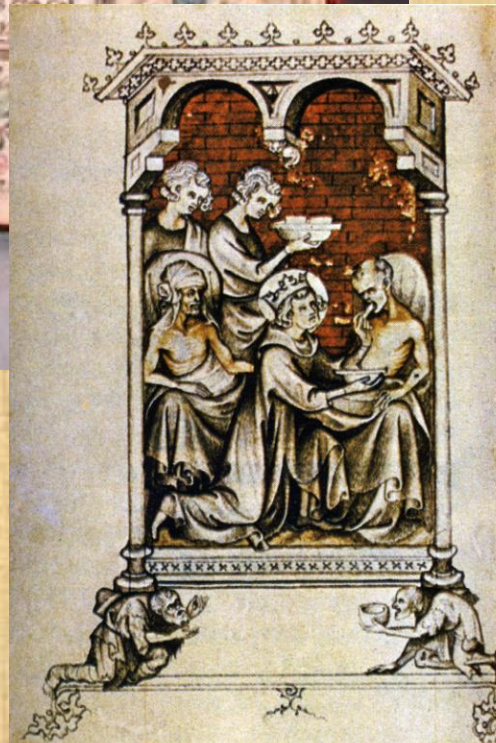

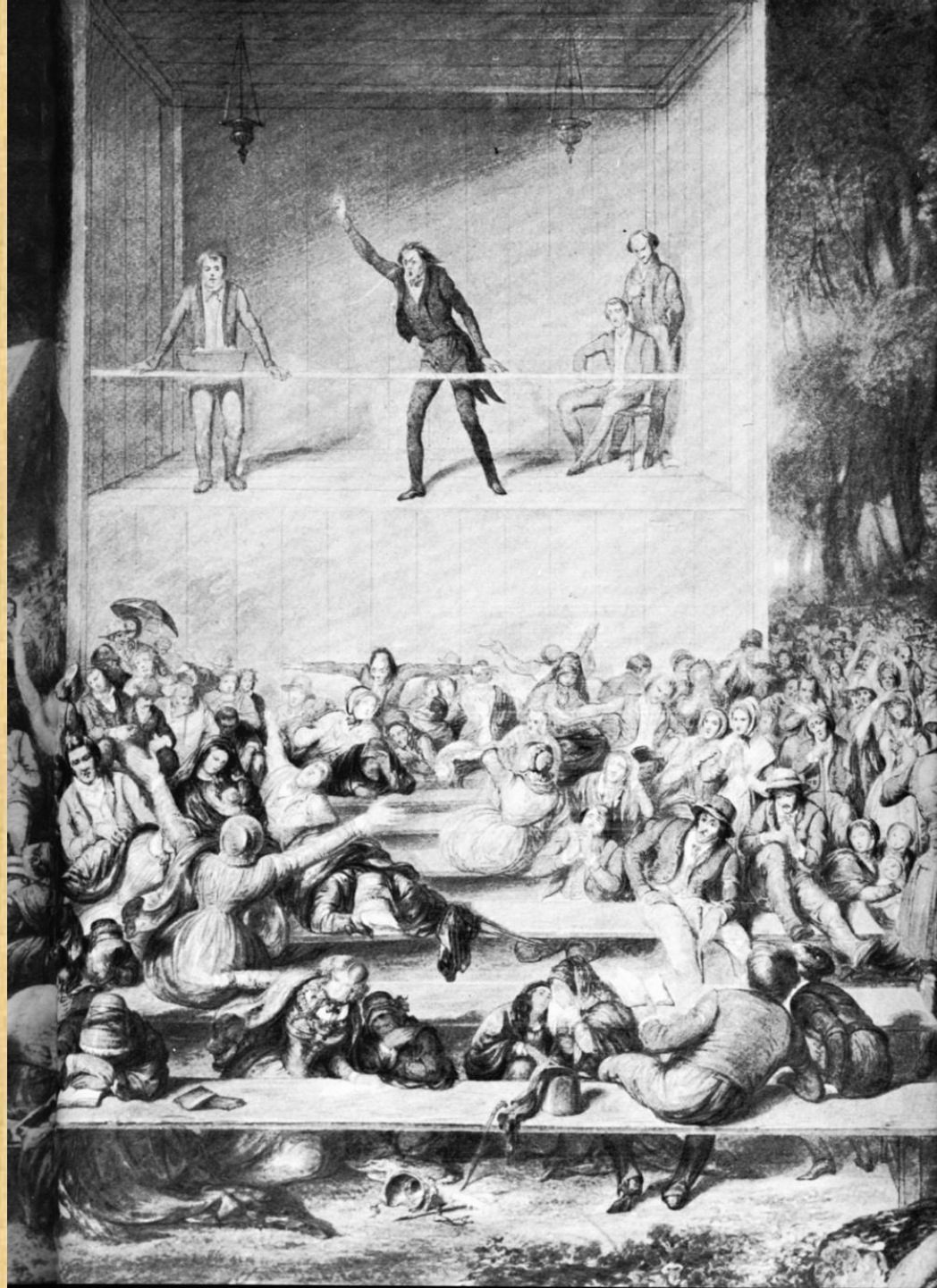
