THEMATIC WORSHIP A Rich Feast for the People of God

"Praise him according to his excellent greatness." (Psalm 150:2)

I. DEFINITION OF THEMATIC WORSHIP

A service where a single aspect of God's nature or work is focused on and celebrated, with the various elements of the service chosen to support and develop that theme.

II. BENEFITS OF THEMATIC WORSHIP

Lingering: a single-minded focus

Learning: a catechetical function

Savoring: time for reflection

Responding: a provision for response

Uniting: a unifying, God-centered focus,

Cultivating: a preparation for preaching

III. TYPES OF THEMATIC WORSHIP

A. Seasonal

- 1. Church calendar (Christmas, Easter, Pentecost, Ascension, etc.)
- 2. Other (Reformation Sunday, New Year's, July 4*, Mother's Day)
- B. <u>Attribute of God</u> (love, grace, holiness, power, etc.)
- C. <u>Biblical Theme or Doctrine</u> (creation, cross of Christ, Lamb of God, heavenly worship, name(s) of Jesus, the Lord my Shepherd, etc.)

IV. CHOOSING A THEME

- A. Follow the calendar
- B. Follow the preacher
- C. Follow the anthem
- D. Cover basic doctrines and attributes regularly

V. MATERIALS FOR THEMATIC WORSHIP

- A. <u>Primacy of the Word of God</u>
- B. <u>Musical Materials</u>
 - hymns and choruses
 - individual verses
 - choral anthems, solos (also brief excerpts)
 - unfamiliar texts to familiar tunes
 - inclusio (bookends)

C. <u>Textual Materials</u>

- Hymn texts
- Original responsive readings
- Other biblically sound readings (creeds, Te Deum, Pilgrim's Progress, Book of Common Prayer, quotations)
- Written prayers (original; also from Valley of Vision; Worship Sourcebook; Leading in Prayer by H.O. Old; denominational resources; etc.)

D. <u>Visual Materials</u>

- Banners
- Bulletin covers
- Projected verses, titles, art works, photographs, drawings
- Symbolic objects (shepherd's crook, telescope, etc.)

VI. REINFORCING THE THEME

- Bulletin, newsletter: next Sunday's theme
- Visual elements upon entry
- Read passage for meditation
- Projected verse or title
- Call to worship; introductory remarks/prayer
- Seamless flow; few instructions
- Transition to sermon

- "The rest of the story"
- Time and planning

VIII. THE POWER OF THEMATIC WORSHIP

The potential to nourish the soul and galvanize the worship of God's people by giving attention to a single, God-centered focus and allowing time for reflection and response.
