B2: Worship: A Spring of Life and Shalom—Mariano Avila

Worship helps us answer fundamental questions of human existence regarding our identity, calling, main purpose in life, and how to be empowered for service to God. We will carefully review key biblical passages that answer these questions, showing how worship can become a source for deep gratitude, clear vision and constant empowerment to face life's challenges.

Worship is to please God, not ourselves

Worship is not a magic act, to manipulate God; it is to please and serve him.

Doing Justice and Being Responsible Stewards:

Sabbath year: Ch. 25:1-7 Ecological and humanitarian Jubilee Years. Ch. 25:8-55 Land and social rest; economical restoration and self-sufficiency.

Nota Bene: Do not forget that **ch.26** deals with the **blessings** that come because of obedience to the Torah, **and the curses** that result of disobedience to **Berith** (26:42).

4. Numbers:

The time: In chs. 28-29 we learn about the times for the offerings:

All the time of our life should be consecrated to God.

There are several cycles that encompass daily life in worship:

Daily --Twice a day 28:3-8
Weekly--Sabbath 28:9-10
Monthly--New Moon (monthly) 28:11-15
Yearly--Festivals (One week long)

First Month: **Passover:** 28:16-25

Third Month: Feast of the Weeks (Pentecost):

28:26-31

Seventh Month: Festival of the trumpets

/Day of Atonement 29:1-11

Festival of Booths/Tents 29:12-38

Sabbath Year: Rest for the Land, provision for the poor

25:1-7

The Year of Jubilee: Liberty and justice for All:

Lev. 25:8-54.

5. Deuteronomy: The nature of worship: key chapter: 26.

This is one of the earliest and few liturgies we have for education in Shalom and justice:

Gratitude: Is the fertile soil where worship grows. What we are and have are Gifts of God. (vv.1-4)

Memory: Of our origin, pilgrimage, and the way the Lord has sustained us (5-10)

Commitment to God expressed in our solidarity to our neighbors (vv. 11-12. Also Mt 5:21-26; 25:31-46, 1 Co. 11:17-34, James 1:27; 2:14-17, 1 John 3:16-18; 4:20-21)

God's blessing comes as a response to our obedience (vv. 13-15).

Worship as a renewal and re-enactment of God's covenant.

Importance of a continuous reminder; the heart of rituals and ceremonies. (vv. 16-19).
