



Word of challenge, **Come, be with us.**

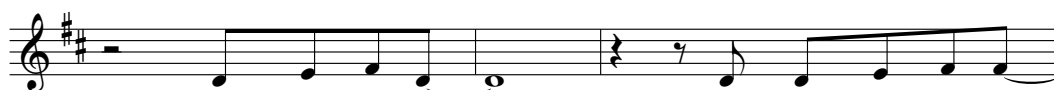
