LACK OF ROBUST TRANSIT SYSTEM

53% of survey respondents report inadequate transit as their biggest pain point. Residents echo support for service area expansion and high-speed rail between Dallas and Fort Worth.

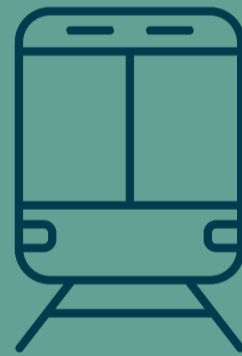


CYCLISTS AND PEDESTRIANS FEEL UNSAFE

The public desires separated bike lanes, wider sidewalks, and enhanced crosswalks to improve safety and encourage alternative modes of transportation.

REQUESTS FOR VIABLE ALTERNATIVES

Residents feel a heavy reliance on personal vehicles creates higher demand for alternatives such as light rail.



ROADWAYS NOT KEEPING PACE WITH GROWTH

Only 34% of survey respondents report that roadways meet their needs for providing access to jobs. Suggestions include lane widening, speed enforcement, and assessing toll road affordability.
