- Funding Recommendations (FY2024-2025)
 - The committee recommends: Splitting the currently available \$73,357 between Umoja and Buncombe County Youth Justice Clinical Program (BCYJCP):
 - \$50,000 going to the BCYJCP
 - \$23,257 to Umoja
 - To discontinue funding for Buncombe Structured Day for FY24-25. The intent is for the \$66,893 previously allocated to them to be advertised in a second RFP.
- RFP Recommendation (FY2024-2025)
 - The committee recommends releasing a second RFP for the remaining \$66,893 for programs with the priority program types listed below:
 1. Comprehensive Clinical Assessments (CCAs) / Individual or Group Counseling / Substance Use Counseling Services
 2. Restorative Services / Restorative Justice
 3. Structured Day / Tutoring / Academic Enhancement / Mentoring
