APD Operations: Estimated Impact on Jail Population

Two Operations Conducted in October

October 5/October 6

- 25 people booked
- 41 charges, 30 were new charges and 11 were orders for arrest
- Average length of stay: 5.8 days

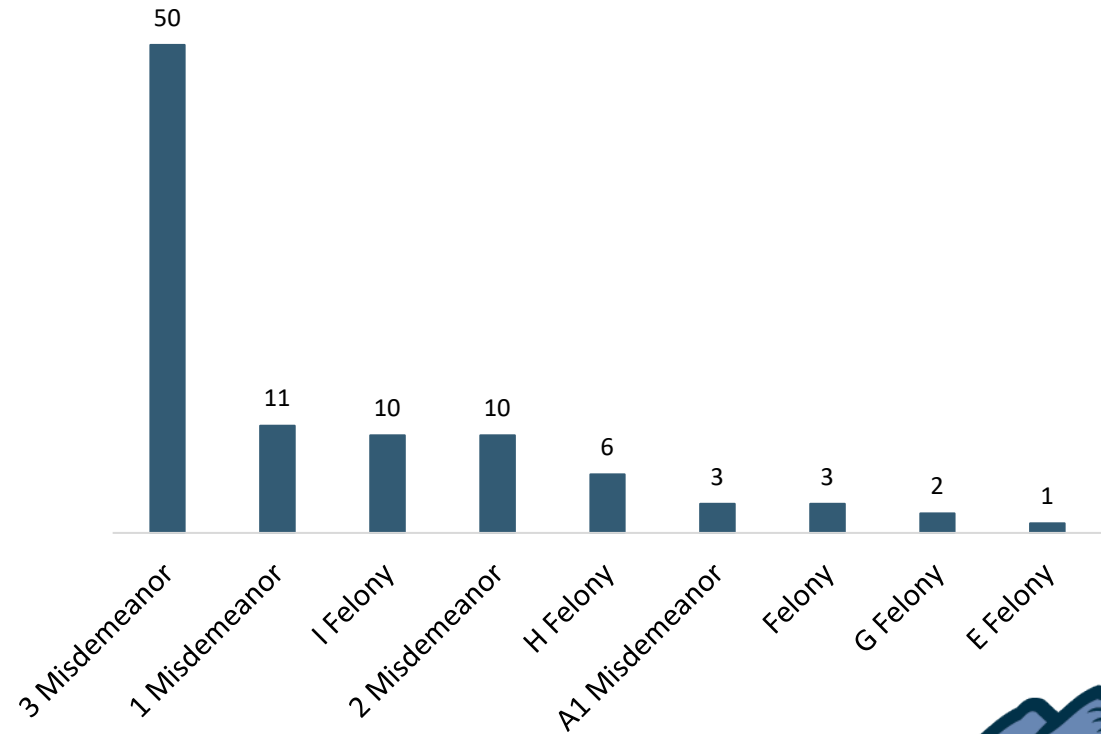
Weekend of October 27

- 31 people booked
- 77 charges, 66 were new charges and 11 were orders for arrest
- Average length of stay: 5.4 days

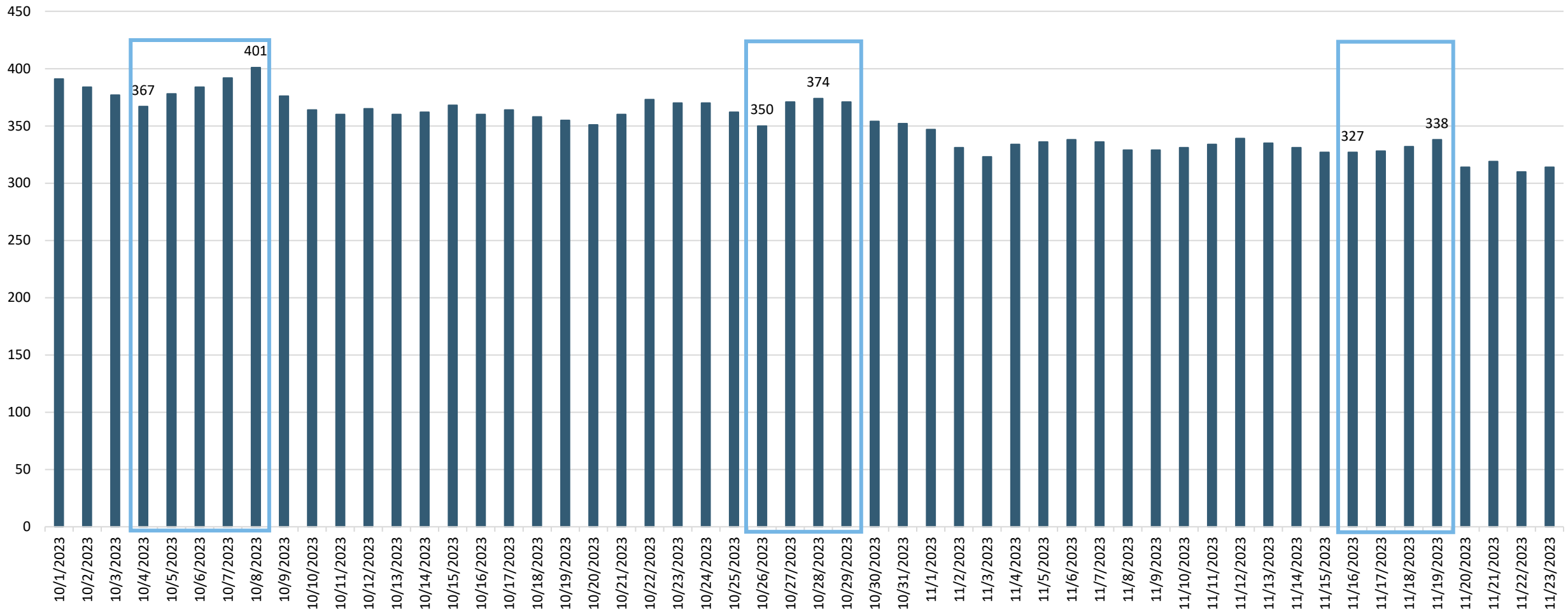

RESISTING PUBLIC OFFICER	2 MISDEMEANOR	5

Pretrial Average Daily Population

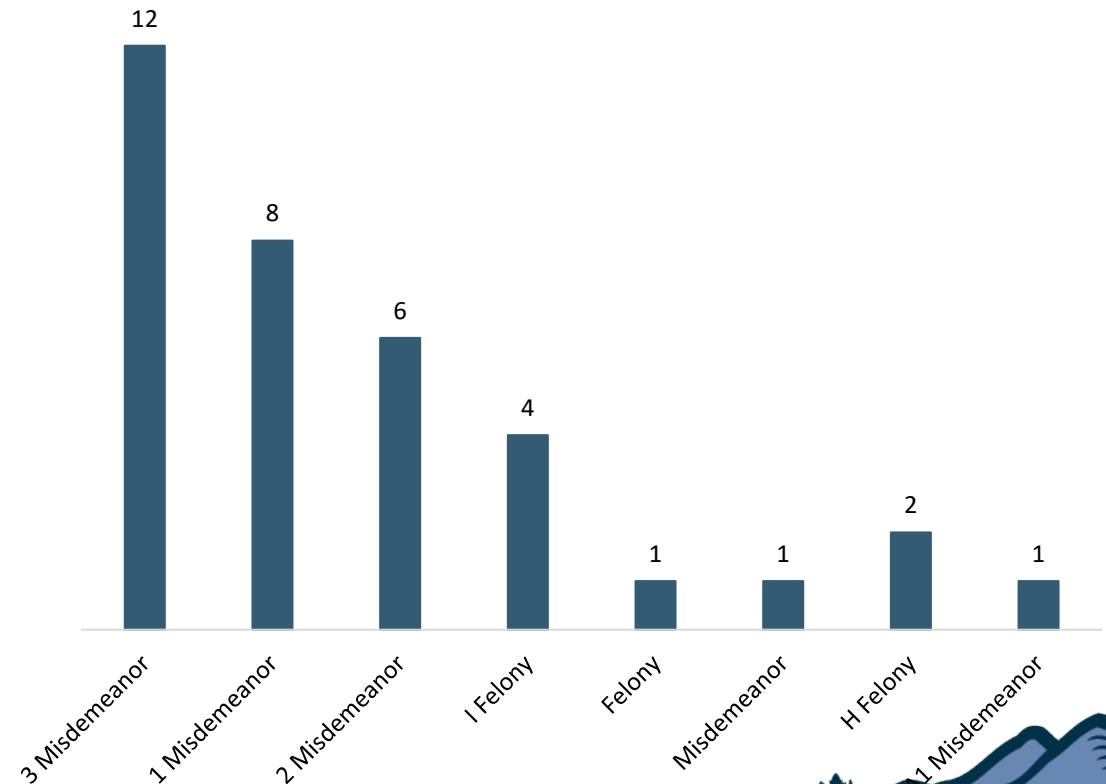


APD Operations: Estimated Impact on Jail Population

41 people involved in the November 17 operation

- 16 people were booked into the jail
 - 7 people booked had orders for arrest for failure to appear served
- 22 people had been booked into the jail within the last 6 months
 - 41 bookings
 - 10 people had been booked more than once
 - 2 people met the definition of a familiar face
- 3 people have been booked since the November 17 operation
