## ACC NOTABLES

• The 12th annual ACC/Big Ten Challenge will be contested this week with five games on Wednesday and nine games on Thursday.

• The 2018 Challenge features a combined seven ranked teams between the two conferences and two Top-25 matchups, including No. 14/15 Iowa at No. 1/1 Notre Dame and No. 12/12 Syracuse at No. 20/RV Minnesota both on Thursday.

• The ACC owns an 81-55 edge over the Big Ten in Challenge games and has won eight Challenge titles. A year ago, ACC women's basketball teams combined for a record 10 wins over the Big Ten to win the 2017 Big Ten/ACC Challenge, 10-4.

• The ACC has five undefeated teams: Virginia Tech (7-0), Notre Dame (6-0), Boston College (6-0), Louisville (6-0) and NC State (6-0). Four ACC teams have one loss: Syracuse (6-1), Miami (6-1), Florida State (6-1) and Georgia Tech (5-1).

• Five ACC teams are ranked in both the AP and USA Today/Coaches polls - led by No. 1/1 Notre Dame. No. 5/4 Louisville follows, along with No. 12/12 Syracuse, No. 153/13 NC State, and No. 21/20 Miami.

• The ACC is 75-23 against non-conference opponents including nine wins over ranked opponents. The ACC went 26-9 during Feast Week, which included five wins against Top 25 foes last week.

• ACC teams combined to win nine Thanksgiving Tournament titles: Hawk Classic (Boston College), Junkanoo Jam (Florida State), Cancun Challenge Riviera Division (Georgia Tech), South Point Shootout (Louisville), Miami Thanksgiving Classic (Miami), Cancun Challenge Riviera Division (NC State), Vancouver Showcase (Notre Dame), Cancun Challenge Mayan Division (Syracuse) and UCF Thanksgiving Classic (Virginia Tech).

• Six ACC players were named MVPs of their respective Thanksgiving Tournaments - Boston College's Marnelle Garraud, Florida State's Nausia Woolfolk, Miami's Beatrice Mompremier, NC State's Grace Hunter, Notre Dame's Arike Ogunbowale and Syracuse's Tiana Mangakahia. Another four were named to All-Tournament Teams.

• Syracuse junior guard Tiana Mangakahia was named the ACC Player of the Week after leading the Orange to a 3-0 week at the Cancun Challenge where she was named the Tournament MVP. Mangakahia averaged 18.0 points, 5.3 rebounds and 7.7 assists in wins over Kansas State, Prince and No. 16 DePaul. The Brisbane, Australia, native poured in 16 points during the final four minutes of regulation and overtime, including the game-winning basket as time expired against DePaul.

• Boston College freshman guard Marnelle Garraud is this week's ACC Rookie of the Week. She averaged 19.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 3.5 assists in a 2-0 week for Boston College as it defeated Loyola and Rider at the 25th annual Hawks Classic last weekend. She was named the tournament MVP for her efforts. Boston College is 6-0 for the first time since the 2010-11 season.

• The ACC is the only conference to win national championships in football, men's basketball, women's basketball and baseball over the last four years.

• The ACC boasts six coaches who rank in the top 20 of winningest active coaches by percentage, the most of any league in the country - 6. Muffet McGraw (.767), 8. Jeff Walz (.761), 10. Wes Moore (.754), 15. Joanne P. McCallie (.727), 19. Kenny Brooks (.721) and 20. Sylvia Hatchell (.720).

• Louisville senior guard Asia Durr and Notre Dame senior guard Arike Ogunbowale are among the five on the Associated Press Preseason All-America Team.

• The ACC leads all leagues with 11 players on the 2019 Citizen Naismith Trophy Watch List. Included on the list are Duke's Leaonna Odom, Louisville's Asia Durr and Sam Fuehring, Miami's Beatrice Mompremier, North Carolina's Paris Kea, Syracuse's Tiana Mangakahia and Notre Dame's Marina Mabrey, Arike Ogunbowale, Jessica Shepard, Brianna Turner and Jackie Young.

• The ACC also leads all leagues with nine players on the John R. Wooden Award Preseason Top 30 Watch List and Wade Trophy Watch List. Included on those lists are Duke's Leaonna Odom, Louisville's Asia Durr, North Carolina's Paris Kea, Syracuse's Tiana Mangakahia and Notre Dame's Marina Mabrey, Arike Ogunbowale, Jessica Shepard, Brianna Turner and Jackie Young.

## WEEKLY/SEASON AWARDS

The Atlantic Coast Conference's "Blue Ribbon Panel," consisting of national and local media members, as well as school representatives, will vote for the league's preseason poll, weekly honors and postseason All-Conference team for the 2018-19 season.

The ACC, with nominations from its 15 member institutions, will designate approximately 35 media members who cover ACC Women's Basketball regularly to the panel. In addition to the 35 members, the league's communications office will invite additional national and selected persons to the panel, including ACC television broadcasters.

Finally, all 15 league head coaches will receive one ballot to vote on preseason and postseason accolades; however, they will not be permitted to vote on a weekly basis or for their own student-athletes.

Following the conclusion of the regular season, the Blue Ribbon Panel will select a 10-member All-ACC First Team, a five-member All-ACC Second Team, an eight-member All-Freshman Team, as well as Player of the Year, Rookie of the Year and Coach of the Year. The league head coaches will also select their own 10-member All-ACC First Team, an eight-member All-ACC Second Team, an All-Freshman Team, Player of the Year, Rookie of the Year and Coach of the Year, as well as, the All-Defensive Team, Defensive Player, Sixth Player and Most Improved Player of the Year.

## 2019 ACC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT AND NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP REGIONAL



Greensboro, North Carolina and the Greensboro Coliseum will be the epicenter for women's basketball during the month of March as the ACC and the city of Greensboro will host the 2019 ACC Women's Basketball Tournament and a 2019 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship Regional.

The ACC Tournament will be held at the Greensboro Coliseum, for the 19th time in 20 years, on March 6-10, 2019. The Coliseum, with assistance from the Tournament Hosts of Greensboro, Greensboro Sports Commission and Convention and Visitors Bureau, is now set to play host to the tournament through 2023. Every attendance record for the 40-year-old tournament has been set at the Greensboro Coliseum, including the overall attendance mark of 73,187 in 2009. Overall attendance at the Greensboro Coliseum has exceeded 60,000 eight times since 2006.

The winner of the ACC Women's Basketball Tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. The tournament seeding and Conference Champion are determined by the 16-game regular-season ACC schedule.

The ACC and the Greensboro Coliseum will also host the 2019 NCAA women's regional on March 30-April 1. The Regional Semifinals are set for Saturday, March 30 at 11:30 and 2 p.m., and the Regional Final for 7 p.m. on Monday, April 1. The ACC was also awarded a NCAA Regional in 2022.

# 2018-19 ATLANTIC COAST CONFERENCE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

## 2018 ACC/BIG TEN CHALLENGE

The Atlantic Coast Conference and the Big Ten Conference announced the matchups for the 2018 ACC/Big Ten Women's Basketball Challenge. This year's Challenge will mark the 12th straight year of the event that pits the two perennially strong conferences against each other.

The ACC and Big Ten conference offices determine the schedule each season, and the official title of the Challenge rotates each year. The 2018 event will be referred to as the ACC/Big Ten Women's Basketball Challenge and will continue to mirror the official title of the conferences' Challenge agreement for men's basketball.

All 14 Big Ten teams and 14 of the 15 ACC teams will participate in the 2018 Challenge.

This year's event will be played in a two-day format beginning on Wednesday, Nov. 28. A year ago, ACC women's basketball teams combined for a record 10 wins over the Big Ten to win the 2017 Big Ten/ACC Challenge, 10-4. The outright title was the eighth overall for the ACC. The ACC owns an 81-55 record against the Big Ten in Challenge games.

After a closely contested first day of games in which the ACC held a slim 3-2 edge, the ACC claimed seven wins last Nov. 30, to clinch the title.
