FAST BREAK

- The Bruins saw a four-game winning streak snapped in a 78-69 home loss to Toledo, despite a career-high 26 points from senior Ellie Harmeyer. It was just Belmont's third loss at home since the start of the 2015-16 season (38-3).
- Belmont is coming off its most successful season in its 20-plus years at the NCAA Division I level. The 2017-18 Bruins rolled to a 31-4 record and their third straight Ohio Valley Conference Tournament championship and appearance in the NCAA Tournament.
- Head coach Bart Brooks (Wyoming) is now in his second season with the program. His 31 wins a year ago tied him for fourth in NCAA history for a first-year coach. He is assisted by Jamey Givens (Florida State), Amy Malo (Vanderbilt) and Christine Clark (Harvard).

MEDIA RELATIONS

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ABOUT THE BRUINS

Belmont is coming off its third straight NCAA Tournament appearance following its best season since joining the Division I ranks two decades ago. The Bruins posted a 31-4 overall record, one off the program's best all-time wins mark, and racked up a program-record 22 straight wins on their way to a program-high No. 12 seed in the NCAA Tournament. Belmont fell in the first round to Duke, 72-58.

Belmont's Ohio Valley Conference Tournament championship was the team's third straight as the Bruins extended their win streak over OVC teams to 46 games, the second longest active streak in the nation.

SERIES HISTORY

Belmont won the only matchup between the two teams, 85-62, on Nov. 25, 2005. The game was played on a neutral court at the University of Memphis Lady Tiger Classic. The teams have never played at Clemson.

COLLEGE SPORTS MADNESS HONORS

Belmont players have been named the Ohio Valley Conference Player of the Week in each of the past two weeks with junior Ellie Harmeyer being honored this past Monday and senior Darby Maggard the week before.

WATCH OUT FOR MAGGARD

Senior Darby Maggard is one of 35 players named to the watch list for the Wade Trophy given to the nation's top college women's basketball player by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association. She was also on the preseason watch list for the Ann Meyers Drysdale Award as one of the top 20 shooting guards in the country.

RECORD REACHED FOR MAGGARD

With 16 points at Northern Kentucky on Nov. 21, Maggard became Belmont's career scoring leader in the NCAA era (since 1997-98) with 1,553 points. She passed former teammate Sally McCabe (1,540 points) for the top spot and now ranks sixth in Belmont's overall program history.

LIGHTS OUT SHOOTER

Maggard ranks second among active NCAA players in 3-point shooting percentage (43.9%) and first in free-throw percentage (92.7%). She is also No. 2 among active players in made 3-pointers (339), assist-to-turnover ratio (2.76) and third in assists (564).

ELLIE'S BIG OUTING

Junior forward Ellie Harmeyer smashed her career scoring best with 26 points against Toledo on Nov. 29. She scored 19 in the second half alone. Her previous high was 20 points, done twice. Her 26 points are the highest by a Bruin player this season.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Harmeyer grabbed a career-high 12 rebounds and scored 11 points on Nov. 19 against MTSU to help the Bruins to victory and notch Belmont's first double-double of the season. It's her fourth career double-double.

ROY THE THIEF

Senior guard Jenny Roy has had two games with five steals this season, once at [17/16] North Carolina State on Nov. 7 and once vs. Toledo on Nov. 29. Before Roy, no Bruin player had at least five steals in a game since Taylor Mills got five against Tennessee State on Jan. 1, 2014.

DOUBLE FIGURES

Both Maggard and Harmeyer have reached double figures in all six games for Belmont this year. Harmeyer has scored no fewer than 11 points with Maggard tallying no fewer than 12.

ONE MORE YEAR

Belmont guard Maura Muensterman has been granted a sixth year of eligibility by the NCAA after a successful eligibility extension waiver petition. A transfer from Indiana, Muensterman missed all but the first three games of the 2016-17 season due to injury.

GOOD TO SEE YOU AGAIN

Belmont knocked off Middle Tennessee State 45-38 on Nov. 19 for the Bruins' first win over the Blue Raiders in more than 40 years. Belmont last beat MTSU on Feb. 11, 1975 before the Blue Raiders reeled off 16 straight victories. They last played in 2000.

FREE THROW PARTY

Of Maggard's 12 points at MTSU on Nov. 19, 10 came at the free-throw line during a perfect 10-of-10 shooting performance there. She set career highs in attempts and made free throws, surpassing her 8-of-8 effort against Tennessee Tech from last season.

OVC RANKINGS

Maggard ranks first in the OVC in 3-pointers (3.7 per game) and free-throw percentage (1.000), as well as second in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.2) and fourth in scoring (16.7 ppg). Roy is tied for third in assists (4.4 per game) and third in steals (2.8 per game) and assist-to-turnover ratio (2.3).

WHAT A DEBUT

Coach Bart Brooks had an all-time great head coaching debut last year in leading Belmont to its 31-4 record. With 31 wins, Brooks tied for the fourth most wins ever by a first-year head coach in NCAA history. The all-time mark is 35 wins, shared by Jody Conradt of Texas (35-4) and Sonja Hogg Louisiana Tech (35-1), both set in 1982. He was honored with the Spalding Maggie Dixon NCAA Division I Rookie Coach of the Year award.

REALLY HIGH RPI

Belmont enters the week at 19th in the latest women's basketball RPI rankings, the only OVC team in the top 90.

MID-MAJOR PROPS

The Bruins are ranked 8th in the CollegeInsider.com Women's Mid-Major poll. That comes after Belmont climbed to the No. 1 spot during last year's run.

THE MORE THE MERRIER

BU holds an impressive 34-1 mark when scoring at least 80 points over the last three-plus seasons. The Bruins scored 80+ points 15 times in the 2017-18 campaign. They have yet to reach the plateau in 2018-19.

RECORD CROWD

A whopping 2,461 fans attended Belmont's game vs. Toledo on Nov. 29, a Curb Event Center record for a women's basketball game. The previous high came last year during Homecoming when 2,278 fans watched the Bruins face Tennessee State on Feb. 24, 2018.

HOME SWEET HOME

The Bruins have been nearly impossible to beat at home the past three-plus years, boasting an unprecedented 38-3 record inside the Curb Event Center. The two losses in that span came to a Green Bay (2016) squad that was receiving votes in both the AP and USA Today Coaches poll and a Wright State (2017) team that was ranked 15th in CollegeInsider.com's mid-major poll. Belmont visits Wright State on Nov. 15 this year.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Belmont has a 37-16 mark in non-conference games over the last three-plus seasons. The Bruins closed out their 2017-18 non-conference campaign with a signature win over Vanderbilt, scoring 111 points on the Commodores. It was the most points scored in Belmont's Division I era as well as the most points ever put up against a Vanderbilt women's basketball team.

POLL POSITION

Belmont achieved a national ranking for the first time in school history in 2017-18, appearing in both the Associated Press and USA Today Coaches Top 25 polls. The Bruins reached as high as No. 22 in the AP poll and No. 25 in the USA Today Coaches poll. It's the first time since 1992 that an OVC school has been represented in the top 25 (No. 22 Tennessee Tech in AP).

VOTE FOR BELMONT

After closing the 2017-18 season ranked 23rd in the AP Top 25 Poll, Belmont again garnered votes in the AP's preseason poll. The Bruins were voted 25th on two ballots to earn two votes overall. BU had four votes in the 2016-17 preseason AP poll.

WINNING WAYS

Belmont piled up 22 wins in a row in 2017-18 to surpass its program-record 21-game win streak set the year before. The 22 straight wins tied a record for the longest win streak in Ohio Valley Conference history.

COOKIN' IN CONFERENCE

Belmont has also won 46 straight conference games dating back to the 2015-16 season, a streak that ranks second in the nation to only perennial national power UConn (101). The Bruins' 46-game streak against league opponents is the longest of any OVC school in women's basketball history (29 by Tennessee Tech is the second longest from 1989-91). They're the first team in OVC history to register back-to-back undefeated conference campaigns.

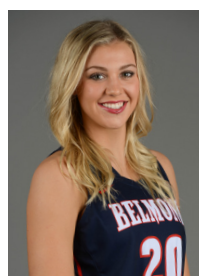

Maggard sets Belmont NCAA-era scoring record

Nov. 21, 2018

NASHVILLE, Tenn. – While she's made a name for herself shooting 3-pointers for the Belmont women's basketball team, it's telling that a major milestone for Darby Maggard came on a shot from just outside the paint Wednesday night. You need to be able to score from everywhere on the court to become a program's all-time leading scorer.

Maggard's pull-up jumper from near the elbow at Northern Kentucky's gym accounted for two points of her now 1,553 for her career, the most by any Belmont player in the program's NCAA Division I era. She set the record during a 71-53 win with a 16-point performance, the latest chapter in a record-book Bruin career. And in true Maggard (Larwill, Ind.) fashion, the point guard passed to her teammates when it came time to collect the glory.

"I'm humbled. I'm honored I get to wear the Belmont jersey every single night," said Maggard, the 5-foot-5 heart of Belmont's offense. "Honestly it's a testament to my teammates because without them there's no way I'd be doing what I'm doing. I'm just thankful this is where I get to play and these are the teammates I get to play with."

With her basket a minute and a half into the second quarter, Maggard moved past recent former teammate and all-time great Belmont post player Sally McCabe (2014-18) for first place. McCabe scored 1,540 points during her four years as a Bruin, the past three playing alongside Maggard.

"My success would not have happened without her. She was a huge reason why I got the scoring record, so it only feels right that I can pass it on to her," said McCabe, who still holds the program record for career blocks (291).

"Darby is such a good person off the court and a real motivator on the court. She gets the best out of you. She works really hard to make you look good and she did a really good job of doing that with me."

While Maggard now owns Belmont's top scoring mark in Division I play, there's a long way to go to reach the program's all-time scoring record. Atop that list is Chrissie Herring (1991-94) and her 2,450 points. The Bruins first 29 seasons following the program's inception in 1968 were spent at the NAIA level before the school made the jump to the NCAA for the 1997-98 school year.

Bart Brooks is entering his second season as head coach of the Belmont University women's basketball program after leading the Bruins to unprecedented heights in his first campaign at the helm.

Brooks piloted the Bruins to a 31-4 overall record in 2017-18, only the program's fourth 31-win season in its rich history and its best mark since 1993-94. The 31 wins are tied for fourth most ever by a NCAA Division I head coach in his first year. For the success he was named Ohio Valley Conference Coach of the Year as well as earning the prestigious Spalding Maggie Dixon NCAA Division I Rookie Coach of the Year award.

Under Brooks' watch, the Bruin women made history last season by becoming the first program at Belmont to earn a national ranking. The team cracked the Associated Press Top 25 at No. 24 in February before climbing as high as No. 22. Belmont also made its way into the USA Today Coaches poll, debuting at No. 25 with two weeks remaining in the season.

Brooks oversaw BU's second-consecutive undefeated conference slate last season, going 18-0 and extending Belmont's winning streak against conference opponents to 46-straight contests -- the second longest streak of its kind in the country behind perennial national power UConn (101). The Bruins reeled off 22 consecutive wins overall in 2017-18, the longest in Belmont history and tying the all-time mark in OVC history, on their way to a third straight OVC Tournament victory and berth in the NCAA Tournament. The team drew a program-high No. 12 seed for tournament play.



Brooks came to Belmont after spending 11 seasons on staff at DePaul University under legendary head coach Doug Bruno. The Blue Demons made the NCAA Tournament every season of Brooks' stint, standing as one of only six NCAA Division I women's basketball programs to make 15 consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances (Connecticut, Notre Dame, Oklahoma, Stanford, Tennessee).

In that time, Brooks coached six WNBA draft choices – Jenna Rubino, Allie Quigley, Felicia Chester, Keisha Hampton, Brittany Hrynko and Jessica January. January was also named to the CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team, the first DePaul student-athlete so honored.



Brooks' DePaul teams were named in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Team Academic Top 25 in the final nine seasons of his stay. Belmont helped run the coach's academic streak to 10 years by posting the nation's 13th best GPA in the 2017-18 academic year.

Brooks began his coaching career at Barry University (Fla.), where he earned in master's degree in sport management. A native of Buffalo, Wyo., Brooks earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology and health from the University of Wyoming in 2004.

He is married to the former Charlene Smith, who played five years professionally including time with the WNBA Houston Comets. They are parents to Trey and Tyler.
