UNC VISITS CLEMSON ON SUNDAY

- Carolina looks to go back above .500 in league play when visiting Clemson on Sunday. The Tar Heels are 14-10 overall, 5-5 in the ACC, after their 85-69 loss to Duke on Thursday. Clemson is 17-5, 6-4 in conference play. The Tigers won at Wake Forest on Thursday, 69-53, to snap a three-game losing streak.
- Carolina leads 56-28 in the series with Clemson. UNC is 23-2 against the Tigers since the 2001-02 season, but did fall 78-67 in the last meeting at Littlejohn Coliseum.
- UNC was named the NCAA.com Team of the Week after wins last week over Georgia Tech and previously unbeaten No. 7 NC State.
- Paris Kea leads the ACC in conference games only at 19.6 points per game.
- Janelle Bailey scored a team-high 23 points on Thursday against Duke. It marked the ninth time she has led UNC in scoring this season and the 8th game with 20 or more points.
- Carolina visits Pitt on Thursday at 7 p.m. The Tar Heels return home to host Virginia next Sunday.

• Taylor Koenen is among a group of three Atlantic Coast Conference student-athletes selected to participate as a member of the ACC Autonomy Committee. The three student-athletes hold voting power on proposed NCAA rule changes under the Division I autonomy process.

• Newcomer guard Shayla Bennett was the 2018 WBCA Two-Year College Player of the Year that averaged 20.6 points, 3.9 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game at Gulf Coast State College in Panama City, Florida. She led Gulf Coast State to the 2017 NJCAA national title, scoring 21 points in the national-title game.

• Freshman guard Claudia Dickey is playing both soccer and basketball for North Carolina. She is a goalkeeper for the nationally-ranked women's soccer team that reached the NCAA title game in 2018. She made her first basket vs. Howard (12/28).

• Leah Church helped lead Team USA to an undefeated record at the inaugural FISU America Games, held July 2018 in Brazil. Team USA knocked off host Brazil to claim the gold medal.

• Paris Kea is just the fourth UNC player to score 1,000 points in the first two seasons with the program, joining an exclusive group that includes Ivory Latta, Marion Jones and Allisha Gray.

• Janelle Bailey led all ACC freshman in scoring, rebounding and double-doubles in the 2017-18 season. She was the only freshman in the ACC to score 30 in a game last season, while her 19 rebounds was the most by a Carolina player since Jessica Breland had 23 against Duke on Feb. 9, 2009.

• Standing 6 foot, 6 inches tall, junior Naomi Van Nes is the tallest UNC player since 6-6 Waltiea Rolle from 2010-13.

TAR HEEL TIDBITS

• Sylvia Hatchell became the ACC's all-time wins leader with an 83-62 win over UNCG on 12/14. Hatchell passed former Virginia head coach Debbie Ryan on the ACC's all-time victories list.

• As of 2/8, Carolina has an RPI of 29 and the No. 3 strength of schedule in the country according to the NCAA.

• UNC and Oregon are the only two "Power 5" schools to have three players averaging more than 15.0 ppg; Bailey (16.8), Kea (16.3) and Watts (15.9).

• Paris Kea is the leading scorer in ACC only games at 19.6 ppg.

• UNC is 4th in the ACC (29th nationally) in shooting 75.3 percent from the free throw line. The Tar Heels set a program record last season converting at 74.3%.

• Janelle Bailey leads all ACC sophomores with 23 career double-doubles, the third highest figure among all active players in the league.

• Bailey leads UNC in scoring (16.8, 5th in ACC) and rebounding (8.9, 4th).

• Stephanie Watts leads the ACC with 3.2 3FG per game.

• Watts had 35 points and nine three-pointers versus UNCW on Dec. 5. Both figures are single-game highs in the ACC this season.

• Watts holds the two highest single game 3-point marks at UNC. She set an ACC record with 10 against Charleston Southern (11/22/16) and had nine vs. UNCW.

• Watts grabbed a career-high 14 rebounds and scored 22 points at Miami (1/20) to notch her first double-double since Jan. 12, 2017.

• Taylor Koenen tied her career high with 21 points in back-to-back games against No. 12 Syracuse and Wake Forest. The junior is averaging 10.9 points in ACC play.

UNC TAKES DOWN TOP-RANKED NOTRE DAME

• UNC's win over top-ranked Notre Dame on Jan. 27 was the third in program history over a No. 1 ranked team and the first since 2006 vs. Duke.

• According to ESPN, the Tar Heel win snapped a 198-game losing streak by unranked teams against the No. 1 ranked team in the country.

• Paris Kea became the fourth Division I player in the last 20 years to have a 30-point, 10-assist game against a ranked opponent (Notre Dame).

HATCHELL THIRD AMONG ACTIVE COACHES IN TOTAL WINS

With 1,019 career wins, UNC Hall of Fame coach Sylvia Hatchell has the third most wins among active women's basketball coaches, trailing Stanford's Tara VanDerveer and UConn's Geno Auriemma.

Tennessee legend Pat Summitt is the all-time leader with 1,098 wins.

HATCHELL BECOMES ALL-TIME ACC WINS LEADER

North Carolina head coach Sylvia Hatchell became the Atlantic Coast Conference's all-time wins leader in women's basketball with an 83-62 victory over UNCG on Friday, Dec. 14 from Carmichael Arena.

Hatchell, in her 33rd season at Carolina, passes former Virginia head coach Debbie Ryan with her 740th victory.

WATTS SCORES 35 IN ROUT OF UNCW, 82-55

Stephanie Watts threatened multiple school scoring records in leading North Carolina to a commanding 82-55 victory over UNCW on Dec. 5. The win was head coach Sylvia Hatchell’s 739th at North Carolina, tying her with former Virginia coach Debbie Ryan for the most wins all-time by an Atlantic Coast Conference women’s basketball coach. Hatchell will go for the record Sunday against UNCG at 2 p.m.
Watts scored 35 points - the most in the ACC this season - and converted nine three-pointers in leading the way for North Carolina (6-4), who snapped a mini three-game skid with the win.

UNC PLAYERS WITH 35+ POINT GAMES

Stephanie Watts is one of only three players in UNC program history to twice score 35 or more points in a game. She scored a career-high 39 points against Charleston Southern on Nov. 22, 2016 and had 35 points against UNCW on Dec. 5, 2018.
Tracy Reid had a school record 42 points against Virginia on Jan. 15, 1998 and put up 41 against Virginia on Jan. 27, 1997. Tresa Brown had 41 points against Virginia on Jan. 14, 1984 and 38 points versus Fairleigh Dickson on 1/9/84.

North Carolina head coach Sylvia Hatchell solidified her place among the legends of basketball when she was chosen for induction into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame as a member of the class of 2013.

Four years later, Hatchell achieved another monumental milestone when she became only the third women's basketball coach in history to reach 1,000 career victories, joining former Tennessee legend Pat Summitt and Stanford's Tara VanDerveer. Duke's Mike Krzyzewski is the only men's coach among Division I basketball coaches to hit the 1,000 mark, and Connecticut head coach Geno Auriemma got his 1,000th victory on the same day as Hatchell on Tuesday, Dec. 19, 2017.

Hatchell's career record of 1,005-390 places her third among active women's coaches by total victories, trailing only Vanderveer and Auriemma, and stands fourth in the history of the sport when you include Summitt, the all-time victories leader and long-time friend of Hatchell.

With a 733-310 mark in 32 seasons at Carolina, Hatchell stands as one of only two coaches - along with former Virginia coach Debbie Ryan - to reach the 700-win mark at an Atlantic Coast Conference school. Hatchell will begin the 2018-19 season, her 33rd in Chapel Hill, six wins short of Ryan's 739 victories she amassed in 34 seasons.

Beyond the sheer magnitude of wins, Hatchell's credentials are sterling. She was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame in 2004, has been named national coach of the year three times and has led teams to at least 20 wins 31 times, fourth-most nationally.

While Hatchell keeps impressive company in many categories, she is also part of an exclusive club that features just one member. When UNC defeated Louisiana Tech to win the 1994 NCAA Championship, Hatchell became the first and only coach to lead teams to national championships at the AIAW, NAIA and NCAA levels. Those titles - the first two coming at Francis Marion - are the crown jewels in one of the most decorated coaching careers in women's basketball history.

Though Hatchell's highly-regarded coaching career has made her a pillar in the sport of basketball, more recently she is best known for her battle with leukemia that forced her to the sidelines for the entire

2013-14 season. Only weeks removed from induction into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, Hatchell was diagnosed with leukemia in October 2013.

Hatchell went through a series of chemotherapy treatments that lasted into March 2014, the same time her Tar Heel team clawed its way to the Elite 8 and was minutes away from a spot in the NCAA Final Four, before falling to Stanford on its home court in the Regional Final. There was hope that Hatchell would rejoin the team if Carolina had reached the Finals Four in Nashville, Tennessee.

In May 2014, Hatchell's doctor announced that she had completed all treatments and would be back on the bench for the 2014-15 campaign. In typical program fashion, the Tar Heels had another outstanding season, posting a 26-9 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

Hatchell continues to be an adamant supporter of the fight against cancer with help from her teammates at UNC Lineberger Cancer Center. Hatchell fills her calendar with numerous speaking engagements to raise money and awareness of the disease.

In June 2016, her book *Fight! Fight!: Discover Your Inner Strength When Blindsided by Life* was released to rave reviews, and within days became the No. 1 Amazon new release in the "cancer books" category.

"I wrote this book because I wanted to help other people as they go through difficult times," Hatchell said. "People are going through some extremely trying things in life, and I'm always inspired by the courage and boldness that they display. All I want to be is a guide for others as they face some unfathomable challenges in life."

The final countdown to victory No. 1000 began at the start of the 2017-18 season just 10 win away from reaching a number reached by so few in the sport. Call it a stroke of luck or perhaps divine intervention, but if it wasn't going to happen inside Chapel Hill's Carmichael Arena then having it occur in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina,

a spot Hatchell has taken her Tar Heel teams for the last 24 years, seemed to be a solid second option. On December 17, 2017 against Grambling State University, UNC recorded a 79-63 win inside the Myrtle Beach Convention Center in front of many of Hatchell's closest friends, former players and family.

Since coming to Chapel Hill in 1986, Hatchell has forged a tradition of excellence at Carolina. Under her direction, the Tar Heels have won a national championship and eight ACC titles, compiled six 30-win seasons and claimed five ACC Player of the Year and eight ACC Rookie of the Year honors. "With the reputation of the school, the image, the location and the athletic programs - including the men's basketball program - I knew we could build a tremendous women's basketball program here," Hatchell said.
