CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, who has an 11-2 home record, swept Boston College in three home games by a combined score of 23-14 last weekend.

- The Tigers are averaging 4.4 runs per game and hitting .259 with a .363 on-base percentage, .369 slugging percentage and 22 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 2.91 ERA, .222 opponents' batting average and 2.54 strikeout-to-walk ratio and Clemson is fielding .962.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE OVERVIEW

- Presbyterian College is led by 16th-year Head Coach Elton Pollock.
- The Blue Hose lost all three home games against Connecticut. They are hitting .193 and have an 8.24 ERA and a .936 fielding percentage.
- Kyle Merkle and Landon Shaw both have two home runs, while Kyle Benson has the team's lone save.

WINTHROP OVERVIEW

- Winthrop is led by 10th-year Head Coach Tom Riginos.
- The Eagles won two of three games at George Mason last weekend. They are hitting .294 and have a 2.88 ERA and .966 fielding percentage.
- Scout McFalls is hitting .389 with six steals, Spencer Yankle is batting .370 with a homer and 14 RBIs and Colten Rendon has four saves.

QUICK HITS

- Winthrop Head Coach Tom Riginos was an assistant coach at Clemson for eight seasons (2003-10).
- Tiger Director of Player Development Ben Paulsen, who played at Clemson (2007-09) and later played in the majors, is the son of Tom Riginos.
- Adam Hackenberg, who has started all 15 games at catcher, is the only Tiger to start double-digit games at one position.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 4,347 fans per home date (13), the ninth-highest figure in the nation and first in the ACC (through games of March 8).

The locker room is closed following games, therefore, postgame interviews are conducted in the auditorium of the player facility. See the opposing contact for opponent interview procedures.

Up-to-date stats, notes, stories and box scores can be found on Clemson's official website (ClemsonTigers.com). Live online video, live audio and live stats can be accessed on the ClemsonTigers.com baseball schedule page. Fans can also follow ClemsonBaseball on Twitter, Instagram and Facebook.

- Entering 2020, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average attendance 26 straight seasons and a top-15 figure 18 years in a row.

POLLS

- Clemson was ranked in the top 25 for the second week in a row on March 9 and is ranked as high as No. 19 in the nation by Perfect Game.
- The Tigers were ranked in the top 25 by at least one poll for 55 straight weeks from May 9, 2016 to April 15, 2019.

ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is tied for first place with Notre Dame in the ACC Atlantic Division standings with a 3-0 league mark.
- Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is tied for first place with Miami (Fla.) and Notre Dame.

SCORING STREAK

- Clemson has scored at least one run in 121 consecutive games.
- The last time Clemson was shut out was March 16, 2018, when No. 10 NC State blanked the Tigers 4-0 at Doug Kingsmore Stadium.
- The 121-game streak is the third-longest active streak in the nation.
- Eastern Kentucky (174) and Oklahoma State (151) have the two-longest active streaks.
- The Clemson record for longest streak scoring at least one run is 232, set between May 10, 1982 to May 3, 1986.

ARMS CARRYING TIGERS

- Clemson's 12-3 start to the season is due in large part to its performance on the mound.
- Clemson has a 2.91 ERA, .222 opponents' batting average and 170 strikeouts in 136.0 innings pitched.
- The staff has a 11.3 strikeout-per-nine-innings-pitched mark and 2.54 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
- Clemson is holding opponents to .185 with runners on base, .171 with runners in scoring position and .050 with the bases loaded.
- Tiger pitchers have allowed just nine of 45 inherited baserunners to score.
- Clemson has pitched three shutouts and has held the opponent to three runs or less in 10 of the 15 games.
- The Tigers are 5-0 in one-run games and 3-1 in two-run games.
- Over four games from Feb. 19-23, Clemson held opponents scoreless for 33 consecutive innings, its longest streak since May 3-9, 1967 (38).
- Clemson has been aided significantly by the return of righties Carter Raffield and Spencer Strider, who missed last season due to injury.

GILBERT SHUTTING THE DOOR

- Freshman lefthander Geoffrey Gilbert has been one of the first pitchers Head Coach Monte Lee calls on out of the bullpen.
- He is 1-0 with an 0.75 ERA, a .167 opponents' batting average and 13 strikeouts in 12.0 innings pitched over seven relief appearances.
- He is holding opponents to .059 with runners on base, 0-for-11 with runners in scoring position and .077 with two outs.
- He has not allowed any of his six inherited baserunners to score.
- He pitched 5.0 combined innings without allowing a run in two relief outings against Boston College on March 6, 8.

HENDERSON SPARKING THE TIGERS

- Sophomore outfielder and infielder Elijah Henderson only had 32 at-bats in 2019, but he has emerged as one of the Tigers' top hitters.
- He has made six starts at second base, five starts in right field and four starts in left field.
- He is hitting .327 with six doubles, 11 RBIs, eight runs, a .449 on-base percentage and three steals in 15 games (15 starts) in 2020.
- He has 11 walks and two hit-by-pitches against only six strikeouts.
- He hit a walkoff single in the 10th inning in the 1-0 win over Stony Brook on Feb. 22. He reached base in all five plate appearances.
- In his career, he is hitting .264 with six doubles, a homer, 16 RBIs, a .387 on-base percentage and three steals in 34 games (23 starts).

MEREDITH GETTING ON BASE

- Sophomore outfielder Kier Meredith is doing what he has always done best...finding a way to get on base.
- He has a .485 on-base percentage thanks in large part to six walks and five hit-by-pitches against only five strikeouts in 2020.
- He has reached base via a hit or walk in all 15 games in 2020.
- He is hitting .386 with three doubles, a homer, five RBIs, nine runs and three steals in 15 games (15 starts).
- He is hitting .448 with runners on base and .389 with runners in scoring position.
- He went 4-for-5 with with a double, RBI and run against East Tennessee State on Feb. 25.
- He went 4-for-5 with a homer, double, two RBIs and two runs at South Carolina on Feb. 28.
- He was named ACC Player-of-the-Week on March 2, as he was 11-for-18 (.611) with two doubles, a homer and three RBIs in four games.
- In his career, he is hitting .308 with six doubles, a triple, two homers, 11 RBIs, a .458 on-base percentage and nine steals in 37 games.
- He was hampered by injury in each of his first two seasons (2018,19), playing a total of only 22 games (20 starts) those two years.

SHARPE PROVIDING DUAL ROLE AGAIN

- Sophomore utility player Davis Sharpe is continuing his dual role from his freshman season by doing the same in 2020.
- He is 1-1 with a 3.93 ERA, .270 opponents' batting average and 20 strikeouts against four walks in 18.1 innings pitched over four starts.
- He is hitting .306 with two homers, two doubles, five RBIs, four runs, a .457 on-base percentage and a steal in 11 games on offense.
- In his first two starts of 2020 (against Liberty and Stony Brook) in February, he pitched 11.0 scoreless innings with 12 strikeouts.
- In his career, he is 8-5 with a 3.33 ERA and 104 strikeouts against 37 walks in 102.2 innings pitched over 19 appearances (18 starts).
- In his career, he is hitting .273 with six doubles, five homers, 23 RBIs, a .395 on-base percentage and four steals in 49 games (45 starts).

SPIERS CLOSING THE DOOR AGAIN

- Senior righthander Carson Spiers moved into the closer role in 2019 and is in the same role in 2020.
- He is one of only two seniors on the 2020 team, joining righthander Sheldon Reed.
- He is 3-0 with four saves, an 0.00 ERA, a .114 opponents' batting average and 14 strikeouts against three walks in 13.0 innings pitched.

NOTES

- He has made a team-high eight relief appearances.
- He has allowed just one of his seven inherited baserunners to score in 2020.
- In his career, he is 7-7 with 19 saves, a 2.52 ERA and 100 strikeouts against 38 walks in 107.0 innings pitched over 70 relief appearances.
- His 19 career saves are tied for third most in Tiger history. The school record is 34, held by Scott Winchester (1993-95).
- He has allowed just 70 hits in his career, good for a .183 opponents' batting average.
- His 5.89 hits-per-nine-innings-pitched mark in his career is third in Clemson history.
- He has allowed just 14 of his 81 inherited baserunners to score in his career.

WEATHERLY STORMING BATTERS

- Junior lefthander Sam Weatherly has emerged as Clemson's Friday starter on the mound in 2020.
- He is 2-0 with an 0.79 ERA, .096 opponents' batting average and 43 strikeouts against 14 walks in 22.2 innings pitched over four starts.
- He has allowed just seven hits, including no homers.
- He is holding opponents to .088 with runners on base and .091 with two outs.
- He earned national player-of-the-week honors by Collegiate Baseball in back-to-back weeks in late February and early March.
- He pitched 6.0 scoreless innings of two-hit ball with 14 strikeouts (most by a Tiger since 1996) against Stony Brook on Feb. 21.
- He pitched 7.0 hitless and scoreless innings with 11 strikeouts to earn the win at South Carolina on Feb. 28.
- He received the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the South Carolina series.
- In his career, he is 4-0 with a 3.48 ERA and 106 strikeouts in 72.1 innings pitched over 33 appearances (nine starts).
- He has given up just 48 hits in his career, good for a .195 opponents' batting average.
