HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE

- Clemson is looking for its 40th win in the series against NC State. A victory on Friday would make NC State just the second school which Clemson has earned 40 or more victories against. Furman is the only other school to have been defeated 40 or more times by the Tigers.
- Clemson has shutout NC State in 19 matches.
- Mike Noonan is 9-1 against NC State during his 32-year coaching career.
- Entering Friday, Clemson has won 10 of the past 11 matches in the series.
- This will be the 54th consecutive year in which the two side have played one another, making it the longest streak in Clemson history. The two teams first met on Nov. 11, 1967.

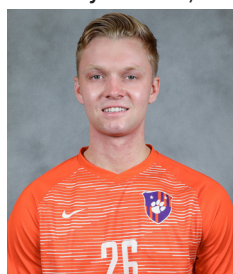

- Noonan** has won 62 matches without allowing a goal during his 11 years at the helm of Clemson's program.
- The 2019 season saw the team combine for 10 shutouts across 22 matches.
- Clemson's shutout percentage (0.455) during the 2019 season ranked second in the ACC and 22nd in the nation.
- Clemson ranked third in the ACC and 28th in the country,

for team goals against average (0.923/game).
