- Six different players saw action in every game this season. Oskar Agren led the team in minutes, with 1,950 across all 22 games.

OFFENSIVE PRODUCTION

- Clemson scored 70 goals, the most since 1993, and contributed 74 assists, the most 1998.
- Clemson's 70 goals last season were the eighth-most by a D-I team in a season since 1998.
- Clemson's dominance resulted in the team tallying 214 points, the most since 1998.
- 14 different players scored for the Tigers, while 16 players contributed an assist.

ACC DOMINANCE

- For the first time during Mike Noonan's tenure, Clemson won the ACC Regular Season title in 2019.
- Clemson was the ACC Atlantic Division champion after being picked to finish fifth in the division by the ACC in the preseason head coaches poll.
- Clemson ranked atop the conference in nine different categories, with all nine coming on the offensive side.
- There were 17 categories in which Clemson ranked within the top-5 of the conference for.

TIGERS IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

- Clemson ranked atop the national rankings in seven different team categories.
- There were 10 categories in which Clemson ranked within the top-5 of on a national level.
- Robbie Robinson was the individual leader in four individual categories by the end of the season.

TIGERS IN THE POLLS

- Clemson reclaimed the top spot in the national polls on Nov. 12, 2019, for the first time since Sept. 18, 2006.
- The Tigers earned an average ranking of 6.46 throughout the season in the United Soccer Coaches weekly poll.
- Clemson spent nine weeks within the top 10 of the national poll.
- Clemson was ranked within the top five of the national poll across six weeks.

AFTER THE FINAL WHISTLE

- Robbie Robinson became Clemson's third winner of the MAC Hermann Trophy for his achievements in 2019.
- Robinson became the first men's soccer player to be named the ACC Male Athlete of the Year.
- Clemson had four All-Americans, five All-South Region honorees, seven All-ACC honorees, two ACC All-Freshman recipients, and two ACC Offensive Players of the Week.
- Clemson had seven seniors finish their Clemson men's soccer career.
- Robinson, Tanner Dieterich and Malick Mbaye were drafted on the first day of the 2020 MLS SuperDraft.
- Robinson became the first Clemson men's soccer player to be selected No. 1 overall in a professional draft.
- Robinson was just the second Clemson athlete to ever be selected No. 1 overall in a professional draft, joining Kris Benson who was the first selection by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the 1996 MLB Draft.
- Charlie Asensio, Oskar Agren, and George Marks were named members of the All-ACC Academic Team for men's soccer.
- Clemson had 21 members of its 2019 squad named to the 2019-2020 ACC Academic Honor Roll.

MILESTONES ACHIEVED

- Head Coach Mike Noonan earned his 100th victory at Clemson against Furman on Sept. 24, 2019. Noonan is joined in all of his victories at Clemson by Associate Head Coach Phil Jones.
- George Marks earned CoSIDA Academic All-Region honors.
- Three members of Clemson's 2019 squad were drafted in the 2020 MLS SuperDraft.
- Robinson was drafted No. 1 overall by Inter Miami CF, becoming the first men's soccer player at Clemson to receive the honor.

HEAD COACH MIKE NOONAN

SIGNING UP FOR MORE

- Clemson's Board of Trustees approved a new six-year



contract for Head Coach **Mike Noonan** on Feb. 6, 2020. The deal will start in 2020 and will run through the 2025 season.

- **Noonan's** 115 wins at Clemson brings his career total to 339 throughout his 32-year career.
- Noonan ranks tied for 12th amongst active NCAA Div. I men's soccer coaches in career victories.
- Noonan is tied with Greg Gelnovatch of Virginia with 339 wins each.

MORE GOALS, MORE SUCCESS

- In **Noonan's** 11 years at Clemson, his side scored three or more goals in 50 matches.
- In the 50 matches, **Noonan** is undefeated.
- When **Noonan's** side scores three or four goals in a match, they are 37-0-2.
- When **Noonan's** side scores five or more goals in a match, Clemson is 11-0-0.
- When Clemson scores first, they are 101-8-7 overall under **Noonan**.

DEFENSE MATTERS

- **Noonan** has won 63 matches without allowing a goal during his 11 years at the helm of Clemson's program.
- The 2019 season saw the team combine for 10 shutouts across 22 matches.
- Clemson's shutout percentage (0.455) during the 2019 season ranked second in the ACC and 22nd in the nation.
- Clemson ranked third in the ACC and 28th in the country, for team goals against average (0.923/game).
- With Noonan at the helm, Clemson has only allowed their opponent to score five or more goals one time. The lone occurrence was in a 5-2 defeat against Duke on Sept. 16, 2011.

SCORING WHEN IT COUNTS

- When **Noonan's** team scores in the final 10 minutes of regulation or in overtime, Clemson boasts a 48-4-3 record.
- Clemson has won 19 of its 22 games when scoring in the first 10 minutes to the match with Noonan at the helm.
- **Grayson Barber** notched four game-winning goals during the 2019 season, ranking fifth in the ACC and 30th in the country for the category.

RETURNING TO THE TOP

- Clemson returned to the top of the national rankings when they became ranked No. 1 by the United Soccer Coaches poll on Nov. 12, 2019.
- **Noonan** is 25-12-10 overall against opponents ranked in the top 25 during his 10 years at Clemson.
- Clemson is 1-1 when ranked No. 1 overall during the Noonan era at Clemson.

MILESTONES ACHIEVED

- **Head Coach Mike Noonan** earned his 100th victory at Clemson against Furman on Sept. 24, 2019.
- **Noonan's** first win at Clemson was on the same field in Greenville, S.C., against Furman on Sept. 22, 2010.
- **Noonan** is joined in all of his victories at Clemson by Associate Head Coach **Phil Jones**.

- Robbie Robinson became Clemson's first men's soccer player to be selected No. 1 overall in the MLS SuperDraft during the 2020 edition of the event.
