THE MATCHUP

- Pitt begins its final road trip of the fall regular season at No. 3 Clemson Thursday at 7 p.m.

LAST TIME OUT: MIAMI

- Pitt defeated Miami 2-0 on Sunday, Oct. 18 in the fall home finale.
- Kate McKay** headed in a corner kick from Hailey Davidson in the 67th minute for the game-winning goal.
- Amanda West** added an insurance goal in the 78th minute.
- Pitt had the decisive advantage in shots (24-8) and shots on goal (8-2).

ACC TOURNAMENT SPOT ON THE LINE

- Sitting in eighth-place in the ACC standings with nine points (3-3-0) and with two games left, the Panthers are in a position to make the ACC Tournament for the first time in program history.
- As the top-eight teams make the tournament as in years' past, Pitt controls its fate to make its first postseason appearance since making the BIG EAST Tournament in 2010.
- Pitt would clinch a bid with a win over Clemson and a tie between ninth-place Wake Forest (seven points) and 10th-place Virginia Tech (six points), which takes place Thursday at 7 p.m. in Winston-Salem, N.C.
- With two wins this week, Pitt could finish as high as third in the league standings.

TOP MARKS IN THE COUNTRY

- With the strong start to the season, the team ranks among the best in Division I in several categories.
- Entering the weekend, the Panthers lead the nation in total points (81) and goals (29).
- They rank in the top-20 in other team statistics:
- second in scoring offense (2.42 goals per game) and assists (23), 10th in shots per game (15.17), 13th in shots on goal per game (7.08), 19th in corner kicks per game (5.7) and 20th in shutout percentage (0.417).

ROAD WARRIORS

- Five of the nine wins this year are on the road, the most in a single-season in program history.
- Last year on the road, Pitt was 1-7-1 and a combined 2-28-4 in the last four seasons.
- With the difficulties of scheduling due to COVID and the desire to play nonconference games, Pitt has 10 of its 15 games away from home this fall.
- All but one of the seven nonconference games are on the road.

BEST START IN PROGRAM HISTORY

- Pitt started the season 6-0 for the first time in program history.
- The six victories to start the season was the second-longest winning-streak in school history, as the 2015 team rattled off eight wins in a row.
- The Panthers defeated the Citadel twice on the road, 2-1 in overtime and 1-0. Previously, Pitt has beaten Syracuse 2-0 in the home and ACC opener, 1-0 in overtime at Navy and Appalachian State twice on the road in the first week of the year with 4-0 and 7-1 victories.
- The Panthers have a 17-2 goal aggregate for the season, best in the nation.
- Playing 548 minutes and 20 seconds in the six-game span, the Panthers only trailed in 11 minutes and 36 seconds, all in the 2-1 comeback win at the Citadel.
- Eight Panthers scored the 17 combined goals.
- Pitt put limited pressure on its goalkeepers with an average of 1.5 saves per game.
- West scored three-straight game-winning goals, something no other Panther in program history has done before.
- West converted two-straight golden goals off penalty kicks at Navy and the Citadel.
- Against the Orange, the Panthers had a dominate advantage in shots (27-4) and shots on goals (12-1).
- The season-opening shutout at the Mountaineers was the biggest-ever margin of victory in a season-opener.
- The Panthers had not defeated an opponent by 4+ goals since a 6-1 victory over St. John's on Oct. 9, 2011.

NATIONALLY RANKED

- Pitt was slotted at No. 14 two weeks ago of the United Soccer Coaches' Poll.
- The previous week the Panthers were ranked No. 12, the first ranking in the United Soccer Coaches' Poll in program history.
- The Panthers were one of six ACC teams ranked.
- The poll has condensed rankings at this time, with only 15 teams ranked that have played a game this season.
- Head coach **Randy Waldrum** has now led five schools to be nationally ranked: Tulsa men's and women's soccer, Baylor and Notre Dame in addition to Pitt.

MOVING ON UP THE ALL-TIME HEAD COACH WINS LIST

- Recording his 416th career win in 27 years at the Division I level against Navy on Sunday, Oct. 11, Waldrum passed **David Lombardo** (Keene State and James Madison, 35 Years) and **Chris Petrucelli** (Notre Dame, Texas and SMU, 30 Years) for eighth all-time.
- Petrucelli's squad at SMU is currently idle this fall, and Lombardo retired after the 2017 season.
- Waldrum currently ranks seventh among active head coaches.

SCOUTING NO. 3 CLEMSON

- The Tigers enter the game with a 5-2-0, 4-2-0 record and have been ranked in the top-10 since the rankings first came out.
- Clemson's only losses have come at No. 1 North Carolina (3-0) and then-No. 11 Duke (1-0).
- Freshman midfielder **Megan Bornkamp** and sophomore midfielder **Caroline Conti** lead the team in scoring with three goals and seven points, as the Tigers have outscored teams 14-4 with four shutouts.
- A transfer from Villanova, junior goalkeeper **Hensley Hancuff** has started in all but one game with a goals-against average of 0.51, 30 saves and .909 save percentage.

THE SERIES

- Clemson has won all five meetings against Pitt.
- In the only meeting between the two programs to go to overtime, last year in Clemson Pitt rebounded from a two-goal second half deficit, but the Tigers got the golden goal for a 3-2 win.

LEADING SCORER IN THE NATION, AMANDA WEST

- **Amanda West** leads the nation in goals (12), game-winning goals (four), points (28), goals per game (1.0), points per game (2.33) and shots on goal per game (2.5) while ranking fourth in shots per game (4.5) and tied for fourth in assists (four) with teammate Kate McKay.
- She hit the ground running this season, just like she did last year, with a goal in the first seven games for the longest goal-scoring streak in program history.
- With only 29 career games played, she already ranks among the top all-time scorers in program history.
 - First in points (57), six ahead of **Ashley Cuba** (2009-12).

- Second in career goals (22), one behind Cuba.
- Tied for third in assists (12) with **Liz Carroll** (2007-10).
- She has recorded nine 3+ point games, the most in school history.
- Her 26 points this year rank 28 points this year rank second and one behind her total last year.
- Her 12 goals this fall are most in a single-season, two ahead of her total last year and **Cande Ruiz** (1998) in 1998.
- She accomplished things in 2019 that no other Panther has done.
- She was named to the United Soccer Coaches' All-Atlantic Region Third-Team, becoming the second-ever Panther to receive all-region honors.
- She became the first Pitt women's soccer player to receive All-ACC honors when she was named to the third and all-freshmen teams.
- She broke the school's all-time single-season points record last year with 29.
- In assists, she tied with **Charity McClure** (1998) and **Katelyn Ruhe** (2010) at eight.

NEW STARTING GOALKEEPER

- The Panthers must replace two-year starting goalkeeper **Amaia Pena**, who signed a professional contract with Athletic Club Femenino (Spain).
- Pitt has three goalkeepers on the roster: **Katherine Robinson**, **Caitlynn Lazzarini** and **Gabriella Neibart**.
- Robinson, the most experienced of the trio, seized the job to begin the year and started the first eight games with only eight goals allowed and 21 saves in 754 minutes played.
- She has recorded three shutouts, including back-to-back against Syracuse and Navy.
- Lazzarini has started the last three games and previously relieved Robinson in both App State games and also against Boston College in the second half.
- She has made eight saves in 331 minutes.
- Prior to this season, Robinson made eight starts in 12 games played over two seasons. Last year she registered a 0-1-1 record with a 2.20 goals against average and eight saves.
- Lazzarini played in four games with three starts last year as a freshman and recorded a 1-2-0 record, 0.95 goals against average and eight saves.

ACC OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- West was named the ACC Offensive Player of the Week last Tuesday.
- She scored two goals each in two Pitt home victories last week against Boston College (4-3) and Navy (4-1).

O CANADA

- Waldrum and his staff have gone north of the border the last two years to find top talent to fill out the roster.
- Six players grew up playing in the Canadian youth soccer system: **Chantelle Parker** (Milton, Ontario), **Leah Pais** (Mississauga, Ontario), **West** (Burlington, Ontario), **Anna Bout** (Cambridge, Ontario), **Chloe Minas** (Montreal, Quebec) and **Bex Bartosh** (Hiawatha First Nation, Ontario).
- Pais ranks tied for second with **Anna Rico** and McKay on the team in scoring with four goals and 10 points.
- Bout and Minas have started in the midfield in each game, and Bout scored her first collegiate goal at Appalachian State.
- Parker started four games at forward before Pitt's last game against Miami.

ACC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- **Kate McKay** was named the first ACC Defensive Player of the Week for the 2020 season.
- As a centerback, McKay played a key role in limiting Appalachian State to just one goal and 13 shots.
- She also contributed on the offensive side. She recorded her first collegiate multi-assist game in the season-opener and scored her first goal in the following game.

RETURNING FOR PITT

- The Panthers return seven starters and eight other letterwinners from last year's team that went 5-10-3 overall and 2-6-2 in ACC play.
- **Amanda West** and **Mackenzie Edwards** started every game last season as freshmen, and **Athalie Palomo** started in every game played with one game missed due to an injury.
- Kate McKay, a transfer from Elon, started in all but one game.
- Sophomores **Krystyna Rytel** and **Anna Bout** combined for 26 starts in the midfield and will look to fill the void of last year's team captain **Juliana Vazquez**, who graduated.
- This year's team still ranks as one of the youngest in the ACC with only six upperclassmen. **Dixon Veltri** is the team's lone senior.

THIS YEAR'S NEWCOMERS

- Pitt welcomes 10 new players to this year's rosters with two transfers and eight freshmen.
- The Panthers are already counting on their newcomers to make instant impacts, as four have started in all four games: **Minas**, **Hailey Davidson**, **Pais** and **Emily Yaple**.
- Davidson came from Oklahoma, where she started two years as a defender and had four goals and an assist as a freshman in 2018.
- Pais won the 2019 America East Rookie of the Year while at Albany, where she tied for the team-lead in goals (five) and tallied 12 points.
- Coach Waldrum brought in one of the most talented recruiting classes in program history, an eight-member class: **Nyla Allen**, **Ione Fetsko**, **Eva Frankovic**, **Hannah Knych**, **Minas**, **Parker**, **Yaple** and **Zaria Stevenson**.

2020 CAPTAINS

- Kate McKay, **Dixon Veltri** and Amanda West were voted team captains, the team announced before its season-opener.
- Veltri is the lone senior on the team and one of four players (**Katherine Robinson, Anna Rico, Celia Lopez** and **Madison Clayton**) to have played for Waldrum for the last three years.
- McKay is one of six upperclassmen on the team.

EASY OUT NO MORE

- The improvement under coach Waldrum's first to second year guiding the program was evident by the team's results last season. Pitt proved to be not an automatic win by fellow ACC opponents, but a team that will play tough against anyone, including the nation's best teams.
- In 2018, the Panthers scored just 11 goals and had a -38 goal differential. In ACC play, they were out-scored 42-2 with an average score of 4.2-0.2.
- Last year, Pitt scored 24 goals with a -8 goal differential. In 10 games of conference action, it was out-scored by only eight goals (20-13) with an average score of 2.0-1.3.
- The Panthers were held scoreless in all but one league game in 2018 and scored against seven opponents last season.
- In 2018, Pitt lost to Boston College 7-0, NC State 6-0, North Carolina 3-0 and Florida State 4-0. The Panthers then beat the Eagles and Wolfpack 2-1 in 2019 and lost only 1-0 at the Seminoles and 3-1 to the Tar Heels.

A DIFFERENT SCHEDULE THAN USUAL

- With the majority of D-I soccer deciding to not play this season, the Panthers and ACC Conference had to be creative with their scheduling the fall season.
- Pitt is slated to play 15 games with eight in league play, instead of the usual 10 conference games.
- The Panthers are set to play more games than any other team in the ACC and is one of two squads to play a non-ACC member this fall (Navy at Virginia Tech, Oct. 24).
- Syracuse plays Pitt twice this season, with the second matchup on Oct. 25 at Syracuse not counting as a league game.

SENIOR DAY

- Pitt's lone senior, **Dixon Veltri**, will be honored with a pregame ceremony before the game.
- A native of Pittsburgh (Fox Chapel High School graduate), Veltri started her career at UNCW but transferred to Pitt after her freshman season in 2017.
- A three-year letterwinner for the Panthers, she has started in 19 of 42 games played as a midfielder.
- She has recorded one career goal and two assists with six of 22 shots placed on goal.
- A two-time ACC Honor Roll selection, Dixon graduates this semester with a degree in Finance, minor in Economics and certificate in Sustainability.

OPT-OUTS

- One player has decided to opt-out of playing this fall season, senior **Hollie Olding**.
- The NCAA has granted all fall sports athletes the opportunity to opt out of competing during the regular season with no repercussions from his/her individual school, such as the loss of scholarship.
- A transfer from Kentucky, Olding played in 15 games last season with seven starts.
- On Sept. 30, Olding signed with Summit Sports Global to start her transition into professional soccer.

HEAD COACH • MIDWESTERN STATE '81 • 3RD SEASON AT PITT



Randy Waldrum enters his third season at the helm of the Pittsburgh women's soccer program in 2020. He was announced as the fourth head coach in Pitt women's soccer program history by Director of Athletics Heather Lyke on December 19, 2017.

The legendary women's soccer coach ranks 14th in NCAA history in career head coaching victories (408) while also ranking sixth amongst active head coaches.

Waldrum oversaw a marked improvement from the team in 2019 with the team finishing 10th in the ACC standings with eight points (2-6-2) and an overall record of 5-10-3. The team snapped a three-year winless streak (0-25-3) in ACC play with a 2-1 overtime win over Boston College at Ambrose Urbanic Field and then defeated NC State 2-1 the following week, who advanced to the Sweet 16 later in the year.

Picked to finish second-to-last in 13th place in the ACC Preseason Coaches' Poll, the Panthers proved to be a tough out for everyone in the best conference in the country. They led NCAA Tournament Runner-up North Carolina 1-0 late in the second half, limited No. 6 Florida State and a top-five scoring offense in the nation to one goal and took both No. 17 Clemson and Wake Forest into overtime on the road after trailing in both games.

Bringing in one of the best recruiting classes in program history for last season and Waldrum's first guiding the program, the newcomers made a huge impact to the turnaround. As one of the nation's youngest programs in the country, Pitt had nine freshmen combined to start 92 matches in the season.

Freshman phenom Amanda West has etched her name all over the Panthers' record book. West broke the schools' single-season points record (29) and tied for goals (10) and assists (nine) with four game-winning goals. She became the first Panther to receive All-ACC honors with spots on the third and freshmen teams and the second one to earn a spot on the United Soccer Coaches' All-Region Team with a third-team nod.

Waldrum saw unprecedented success in his tenure at the helm of the perennial powerhouse Notre Dame women's program. In his 14 seasons, he led the Fighting Irish to two national championships, capturing the College Cup title in 2004 and 2010. His teams won eight Big East Tournament titles and appeared in eight NCAA Final Four games in that span.

A two-time national coach of the year (2009 by Soccer America; 2010 by NSCAA), Waldrum was the first coach in NCAA history to lead a team to a national title in his/her first season with a program. He wrapped up his tenure at Notre Dame with a mark of 292-58-17 (.819) and holds an overall record of 399-108-29 (.771) as a head coach on the women's side. His record ranks fourth in all-time wins as an NCAA women's head coach and third in win percentage.

Waldrum joined the Fighting Irish after beginning a program at Baylor, building the Bears into a threat in the Big 12 from scratch. In three seasons with Baylor, Waldrum guided the Bears to an overall mark of 46-14-3 after spending the 1995-96 starting up the program. He was named the Big 12 and NSCAA Region Coach of the Year after a 15-5-1 record in 1998, as the Bears reached as high as 12th in the nation en route to a Big 12 Conference title.

Prior to his tenure at Baylor, Waldrum spent six seasons at the helm of the Tulsa program, serving as head coach for both the men's and women's programs from 1989-1994. He led the men to a record of 66-33-6 and the women to a mark of 61-36-9, remaining the winningest coach in both teams' history.

In his playing career, he was a standout at Midwestern State University, earning all-district honors in each of his four seasons in Wichita Falls, Texas. He graduated in 1981 with a degree in physical education and a minor in political science. He moved on to play professionally with the Los Angeles Skyhawks and Indianapolis Daredevils of the American Soccer League.

In addition to his impressive resume in the NCAA, Waldrum also spent time in the National Women's Soccer League (NWSL), becoming the head coach of the Houston Dash expansion team in January of 2014. In his three seasons with the Dash, Waldrum coached seven national team players who laced up with their respective countries in the Rio Summer Olympic Games, including Team USA members Carli Lloyd, Morgan Brian and Pittsburgh native Meghan Klingenberg.

Waldrum has also served as the head coach of the United States U-23 National Team since 2012, winning the Four Nations Cup in 2012 and 2013 as well as the Three Nations Cup in 2012.

Waldrum and his wife, Dianna, have one son, Ben, who currently serves on his staff as associate head coach.
