HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE

- This would be Clemson's 15th ACC Championship, the first since 2014.
- This is the second-consecutive year that the nation's top-two teams have played one another in the finals of the ACC Championship.
- Clemson would improve to 3-0 all-time against the nation's top-ranked squad while being ranked No. 2.
- This is the fifth top-five match that Clemson has played in this season, making 2020 the first season in program history that Clemson has played in five top-five matches.
- This is the seventh season in program history that Clemson will face the nation's top-ranked team multiple times in the same season.

- On Sept. 22, 2020, Clemson's men's and women's soccer teams moved into its new Soccer Operations Complex. The new facility cost nearly \$8 million and became the nation's finest soccer-only facility in the nation.
- The men's soccer team joined the Clemson community on June 13 by partaking in a peaceful demonstration organized by Clemson student-athletes and members of the surrounding community. Justin Malou, George Marks and Quinn McNeill were some of the team members present at the event.
- George Marks currently serves as Clemson's SAAC President and is joined by Enrique Montana III and John Martin as members of SAAC. Marks has been instrumental in helping to guide Clemson's student-athletes through the recent discussions surrounding social injustice and has been instrumental in helping student-athletes have their voice heard on social media and on the field of play.
- On Oct. 28, Clemson learned of the passing of former head coach, Trevor Adair. Adair was the program's third head coach and amassed a record of 174-91-26 across 14 seasons leading the team (1995-2008). Adair led the program to the 2005 College Cup, two ACC Championships, nine NCAA Tournament appearances, six NCAA Tournament Quarterfinal appearances, 14 All-America honors and 47 All-ACC selections.

- **Noonan's** 116 wins at Clemson brings his career total to 340 throughout his 32-year career.
- Noonan ranks tied for 12th amongst active NCAA Div. I men's soccer coaches in career victories.

MORE GOALS, MORE SUCCESS

- In **Noonan's** 11 years at Clemson, his side scored three or more goals in 51 matches.
- In the 51 matches, **Noonan** is undefeated.
- When **Noonan's** side scores three or four goals in a match, they are 38-0-2.
- When **Noonan's** side scores five or more goals in a match, Clemson is 11-0-0.
- When Clemson scores first, they are 102-8-7 overall under **Noonan**.

DEFENSE MATTERS

- **Noonan** has won 63 matches without allowing a goal during his 11 years at the helm of Clemson's program.
- The 2019 season saw the team combine for 10 shutouts

across 22 matches.

- Clemson's shutout percentage (0.455) during the 2019 season ranked second in the ACC and 22nd in the nation.
