NUGGETS YOU NEED TO KNOW

- Alabama will remain away from Tuscaloosa for a fourth consecutive game when it travels to Atlanta to compete against Clemson in the Pit Boss Holiday Hoopsgiving event. The Tide and Tigers will play the final game of the day's quadruple header that features three different SEC teams in all including Alabama's contest. Mississippi State will take on Dayton in the opening game of the day (11 a.m. CT), followed by Wofford vs. USF (1:30 p.m. CT). Auburn will take on Memphis (4 p.m. CT) immediately prior the Tide's contest.
- Alabama is riding a two-game winning streak after a fifth-place finish at this year's Maui Invitational, which was held in Asheville, N.C. The Crimson Tide opened the event with a loss to Stanford, however, responded with back-to-back double-digit wins over UNLV (86-74) and Providence (88-71) to close the event.
- Saturday's contest marks the 11th time the two programs will meet on the hardwood. The Tigers owns an all-time record of 6-4 when facing the Crimson Tide, which includes wins in three of the last four head-to-head meetings between the teams. Most recently, Clemson captured a 67-54 win over Alabama back on Dec. 18, 2016 in Birmingham, Ala. UA's last victory over the Tigers came the previous year when the Tide claimed a one-point win (51-50) vs. Clemson in Greenville, S.C.
- John Petty Jr. has made a team-leading 10 three-pointers on the year, pushing his career total to 244 made threes. He now needs only 20 more threes to become the program's all-time leader in the category, which is currently held by Brian Williams (1996-99) who made 263 career threes at Alabama. Furthermore, his 634 career attempts from deep is 105 shy of Williams' program record of 738 three-point shots.
- With the conclusion of the University of Alabama's fall semester this week, senior Herbert Jones has earned his undergraduate degree in business marketing. He is unable to walk at Fall graduation ceremony due to the game vs. Clemson, however, he will walk with five other teammates in UA's Spring graduation ceremony next May.
- This will mark the fourth consecutive game away from Coleman Coliseum for the Crimson Tide, which is the longest road swing of the 2020-21 season. However, Alabama is set to begin a season-long four-game homestand, starting with its next game on Dec. 15 vs. Furman.
- The contest against the Paladins will tip off at 8 p.m. CT and will be televised on SEC Network.

ASHEVILLE, N.C. – The No. 25 Alabama men’s basketball team used balanced scoring along with a dominating rebounding performance to muscle past Providence, 88-71, in the fifth-place game of the 2020 Camping World Maui Invitational.

For a second-straight contest, guard John Petty Jr. led the Tide’s offensive attack with 16 points on the night, which was played on his birthday. Guards Jaden Shackelford and Joshua Primo added 15 each, while Herbert Jones (11) and Jahvon Quinerly (10) also contributed on the offensive end of the floor. Jones also led the Tide with eight rebounds, five assists and a pair of steals in his 32 minutes of action.

However, it was the performance on the glass that helped lead the Tide to the victory. Alabama outrebounded Providence 48-28 in the contest, which included an 18-8 edge on the offensive glass. As a result, Alabama had a 21-9 advantage in second chance points.

Coach Nate Oats Postgame Comments

“I thought our effort was a lot better. I think we’ve made a big improvement over the three days we were here and that’s what we are trying to do is get better. If it took a loss to Stanford to get our guys where they needed to be, then that’s what it took. So, only three teams leave here with a 2-1 record and we are one of them. I think we played really good basketball the last two nights and got better every single game out. Tonight, we didn’t start off great. They hit some tough shots, but our guys just stayed the course. After going down 8-0, I think we went on a 17-3 run and never gave up the lead from there. I told our guys we are going to have to outrebound them tonight in order to win and they answered the bell. Our guys stepped up in areas they needed to step up. It’s Petty’s birthday and he led in scoring, but we also had two other guys with 15. I think Primo is getting more and more comfortable in the offense and playing high-level basketball. I don’t know what it was against Stanford – we didn’t play hard like we needed to, but I think we are clicking now.”

Team Stats

- The Crimson Tide connected on 8-of-12 (.667) three-pointers in the second half after going just 4-of-17 (.235) in the opening stanza
- UA led for 35:01 and by as many as 23 points in the contest before settling for the 17-point win
- Shackelford extended his streak to 19 games scoring in double figures with his 15 points, while also pulling down six rebounds
- Alabama shot 47 percent from the floor, including 53 percent in the second half, while holding the Friars to just 42 percent
- Providence (2-2) could not match the Tide’s efficiency from beyond the arc, as the Alabama defense held the Friars to just 5-of-23 (.217) from deep

First Half

- After trailing 8-0 to begin the contest, Alabama scored 17 of the game’s next 20 points (17-3 run) over the next five-plus minute to take the lead for good
- The Crimson Tide then went on to outscore Providence 19-17 in the final 9 minutes of the half, led by Petty’s 10 points on 3-7 from the field
- With Alabama holding on to a six-point lead, 32-26, with 4:44 remaining, the Tide went on a mini 9-3 spurt over the next 3:18 to take a double-digit lead, 41-29, with just over a minute left in the half

Second Half

- Providence scored six of the first eight points in the half to trim Alabama’s lead to only by seven, 44-37, but that was the close the Friars would get
- With the Tide leading 56-47 with 14:29 remaining, Alabama used a huge 14-2 run over the next 3:26 to extend its lead to 72-49
- However, Providence (2-2) responded with a 12-0 run to slim the lead to 11, 74-63, with 5:51 to go
- The Tide would respond with consecutive made three-pointers by Quinerly and Primo to give UA a 17-point advantage with just over three minutes remaining
- Alabama would finish the half shooting an efficient 53.3 percent from the field while knocking down eight of its 12 three-point attempts after the intermission

ABOUT CLEMSON

- Clemson comes into Saturday's contest sporting a perfect 4-0 record on the year following a 67-51 victory over Maryland this past Wednesday night. The Tigers, considered one of the top defensive team's in the nation through the early part of the season, are limiting the opposition to 50.3 points per game and only once have allowed more than 60 points this year.
- The Tigers return only one starter but welcome back 11 letterwinners from last season's squad. The lone returning starter is Third Team All-ACC honoree Aamir Simms, who currently leads the team in scoring (13.0 ppg) and assists (3.0 apg) while shooting 55.6 percent from the field and 40.0 percent (4-of-10) from beyond the arc. Nick Honor is the only other Clemson player to average in double figures at 10.0 ppg to go along with a team-leading 3.0 steals per game, while Hunter Tyson tops the squad with 5.5 rebounds per game.
- Simms was tabbed to the 2020-21 ACC Preseason First Team by the league media, becoming Clemson's first preseason honoree since 2016 when Jaron Blossomgame earned first team preseason All-ACC honors. Simms was previously named to the Karl Malone Watch List (Top 20 power forwards in the country) and became the first Tiger to earn recognition from the Basketball Hall of Fame's preseason award watch lists
- Clemson boasted a Top-20 recruiting class in the country for 2020 with the additions of PJ Hall, Olivier-Maxence Prosper and Lynn Kidd. It marked the program's highest recruiting ranking since 2009, according to 247Sports.
- The Tigers also return several players from injury last season. Seniors Jonathan Baehre and Clyde Trapp are both healthy after overcoming torn ACL's last year, while Chase Hunter has overcome a foot injury that held him to just nine contests his freshman season. Furthermore, transfer Nick Honor is eligible for the Tigers' in the backcourt after previously sitting out the 2019-20 season due to NCAA transfer rules.
- Head Coach Brownell is in his 11th season at Clemson and his 19th year as a collegiate head coach. He owns a record of 189-142 (.571) with the Tigers and surpassed Cliff Ellis as the program's all-time winningest coach. He boasts a career mark of 356-227 (.611).

ALABAMA MEN'S BASKETBALL QUICK HITS

• Alabama has collected 1,694 wins in program history and is just six wins shy of becoming the third team in SEC history to reach 1,700 program victories, joining Kentucky (2,319) and Arkansas (1,712).

• Saturday's contest begins a stretch of four games in a 10-day span, including two against teams either ranked or receiving votes in the latest national rankings. Following the game against undefeated Clemson (4-0), the Crimson Tide will host Furman (4-1) on Dec. 15, No. 7/8 Houston (4-0) on Dec. 19 before closing the stretch against East Tennessee State (1-2) on Dec. 22. Combined, the Tide's next four opponents are 13-3.

• This year's Crimson Tide squad welcomes back four starters and seven letterwinners from last season's team. Three of the four returning starters were named as All-SEC performers a year ago in seniors John Petty Jr. (second team) and Herbert Jones (all-defensive) along with sophomore Jaden Shackelford (all-freshman). Petty enters the upcoming season as a Preseason SEC First Team honoree by both the media and the coaches, while Jones was named preseason second team by the coaches.

• Head coach Nate Oats returned three players who were forced to redshirt last year (Juwan Gary, Jahvon Quinerly and James Rojas). Quinerly (transfer from Villanova who was not cleared by the NCAA in 2019-20 forcing him to redshirt) was a five star prospect and a McDonald's All-American, Rojas (knee injury) was a JUCO All-American at Hutchinson CC and Gary (knee injury) was the team's highest-ranked signee in the class of 2019 (No. 64 overall, No. 12 small forward and No. 2 player in the state of South Carolina according to ESPN.com).

• Alabama broke every three-point record in program history last year, while also finishing fourth in the nation in tempo and third nationally in scoring offense and three-pointers made per game. The Crimson Tide ended the year by knocking down 334-of-957 (33.4 percent).

• Last season's team finished second in program history with 16 games of scoring 80 or more points. The program record of games of scoring 80 or more points is 17 which was set on three occasions (1986-87, 1978-79 and 1976-77). Furthermore, last year's team reached the 90-point plateau nine times, which tied for second-most in a single season. The 1971-72 team had a school record 12 games of 90 or more points with nine such games also occurring in 2001-02 and 1974-75.

ALABAMA IN ITS 108TH SEASON OF BASKETBALL

- Alabama will begin its 108th season of basketball in 2020-21. The Tide's first season of hoops came in 1912-13. There was no season in 1943-44 due to World War II.
- The Tide holds an all-time record of 1,694-1,062-1 (.616), which includes a 799-626 (.561) record in SEC play. Alabama is just two league wins shy of joining Kentucky as the only two teams in conference history to reach 800 wins.
- Alabama ranks second in the SEC in league victories and all-time winning percentage.
- UA has made 36 NCAA (20) or NIT (16) appearances and has won seven SEC regular-season titles and six SEC Tournament championships.

ABOUT ALABAMA

- Alabama enters Saturday's contest against Clemson sporting a 3-1 record on the season following back-to-back wins over UNLV (86-74) and Providence (88-71) to close out the 2020 Maui Invitational, which was held in Asheville, N.C.
- Four Crimson Tide players are averaging double figures for head coach Nate Oats, including three who are scoring 14.0 points per contest or better in the early part of the season. Guards Jahvon Quinerly (15.3 ppg), John Petty Jr. (14.8 ppg) and Jaden Shackelford (14.0 ppg) are the team's leading contributors on offense. The trio has combined to make 19 of the team's 41 three-pointers on the year, with Petty (10-of-28) and Shackelford (9-of-22) combining to make 19-of-50 (.380) from beyond the arc.
- Forward Herbert Jones, considered one of the top defensive players in the entire nation, leads the team in rebounding (7.0 rpg), steals (1.3 spg), Blue Collar Points (108, 27.0 BCP per game) and Hard Hat Awards (4). He enters the Clemson contest with much improved offensive numbers, averaging 11.8 points and 2.3 assists per contest, while adding 50 percent shooting from both the field (18-of-36) and beyond the arc (3-of-6).
- This season, the Tide welcomed back four starters and five of its top seven scorers off last year's team, three were named as All-SEC performers a year ago. Petty (Second Team All-SEC), Shackelford (All-Freshman) and Jones (All-Defensive) all earned a spot on the postseason teams. Both Petty and Jones tested the NBA waters, with Petty, who was one of the last players to withdraw his name, announcing his return in early August and Jones in mid-June.
- In addition to the returnees, Alabama welcomes six scholarship signees, five of which made up the nation's ninth-ranked signing class according to Rivals.com and the No. 12 overall by 247sports.com. The Crimson Tide signees include Keon Ambrose-Hylton (Toronto, Ontario/Andrews Osborne Academy [Ohio]), Keon Ellis (Fort Myers, Fla./Florida SW State), Darius Miles (Washington, D.C./IMG Academy), Josh Primo (Toronto, Ontario/Royal Crown International) and Alex Tchikou (Paris, France/Dream City Christian HS).
- The team recruiting rankings do not include another new addition in graduate transfer Jordan Bruner. Last season at Yale, Bruner earned First Team All-Ivy League honors after leading the conference in rebounds per game (9.2) and ranking fourth in assists (3.8 apg) and third in blocked shots (1.7 bpg) while adding 10.9 points per contest.
- Head coach Nate Oats is in his second season at the helm of the Crimson Tide program. After finishing last season at 16-15 overall, Oats, who is in his sixth season as a collegiate head coach, owns a career record of 115-59 (.661).

MAUI INVITATIONAL ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

- Following his performance at the 2020 Maui Invitational, John Petty Jr. was selected to the All-Tournament team.
- Across his three games played in the event, the Huntsville, Ala., native averaged 15.0 points and 5.0 rebounds per game while shooting 50 percent (15-of-30) from the floor and 40 percent (8-of-20) from deep.
- The three-game stretch was highlighted when he faced UNLV in the second contest, accounting for a season-high 22 points on 6-of-10 shooting from deep to go along with a six assists compared to only one turnover in his 33 minutes of action.
- Petty was joined on the All-Tournament team by Garrison Brooks (North Carolina), Matt Coleman (Texas), David Duke (Providence) and Trayce Jackson-Davis (Indiana).

LAST TIME VS. CLEMSON

- The last meeting between Alabama and Clemson came on Dec. 18, 2016 when the Crimson Tide fell to the Tigers, 67-54, at the BBVA Compass Vulcan Classic at Legacy Arena in Birmingham, Ala.
- Alabama was led by Avery Johnson Jr. who scored a career-high 17 points off the bench while Shannon Hale added eight points and Donta Hall grabbed a game-high seven rebounds.
- Alabama started the game with six straight points to take an early lead, but quickly saw it disappear as Clemson used a 22-3 run over 7:47 to take a 22-9 lead with 8:16 left in the first half. The Tide trailed 31-19 at intermission.

- UA fought back to bring the score within nine, 57-48, with just over two minutes left in the game. But that's as close as Alabama would come as the Tigers outpaced the Tide 10-6 down the stretch to result in the final score.
- For the game, the Tide bench outscored its counterparts, 34-23. Alabama outrebounded Clemson 37-32 but committed 16 turnovers compared to just 11 for Clemson. As a result, the Tigers outscored the Tide in points off turnovers, 19-12.

PETTY PRESEASON AWARDS

- After being one of the final players to pull his name out of the 2020 NBA Draft and return to Alabama for his final season, John Petty Jr. is beginning to reap the recognition coming into his final college basketball season.
- Petty was named one of 20 candidates selected to the 2021 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award Watch List. The the annual honor in its seventh year recognizes the top shooting guards in Division I men's college basketball.
- He was also honored as a unanimous Preseason First Team All-SEC honoree, earning the recognition by both the media and coaches.
- Petty is coming off a career-best season in 2019-20 on his way to earning second team All-SEC honors. The Huntsville, Ala., native averaged 14.5 points and a team-leading 6.6 rebounds per game last season while shooting 44.0 percent (85-of-193) from three-point field goal range which led the SEC and ranked ninth in the nation.
- Became the 51st player in program history to reach 1,000 career points and the 32nd to do so in three years and enters this campaign with 1,137 career points.
- He enters the year have made 234 threes in 606 career attempts which both ranks fourth in program history. He only needs 30 more makes and 133 attempts to set the program record in each category.

ALABAMA WELCOMES 10 NEWCOMERS TO 2020-21 ROSTER

- Head coach Nate Oats added 10 newcomers to this year's team, which includes six scholarship signees in addition to four walk-ons. - Played his freshman year at Georgia Highlands College in 2019-20 where he averaged 10.1 points, 7.6 rebounds and 1.2 blocks per game while shooting 54 percent from the floor across 32 games
- Helped lead team to a 24-8 overall mark and a 13-3 mark in the Georgia Collegiate Athletics Association (GCAA) where it reached the conference championship game

- Formally introduced as head men's basketball coach at The University of Alabama on March 28, 2019
- Promised fans would see an entertaining, up-tempo and fast-paced style of play and that's exactly what he delivered in his first season at the helm of the program
- After ranking near the bottom of the Southeastern Conference in most offensive categories the previous year, Alabama led the league in six offensive statistics in 2019-20, including points per game (82.0), three-point field goal percentage (34.9 percent) and threes made per game (10.8), among others
- Nationally, the new-look offense ranked No. 3 in points and threes made per game, while also ranking sixth with 334 total threes made and fourth with 957 three-point attempts – both of which set program records
- The Tide's pace of play also ranked among the fastest in the country, as UA ranked fourth in raw tempo (76.1) and average possession length (15.2).
- Alabama boasted four student-athletes who earned All-SEC honors in 2020 as Kira Lewis Jr. (first team), John Petty Jr. (second team), Jaden Shackelford (all-freshman) and Herbert Jones (all-defensive) all received postseason recognition.
- It marked just the second time in program history that the Crimson Tide had four all-conference honorees in the same season (2006 was the only other year).
- His efforts didn't just end on the court. Off the court, Oats and his staff were relentless on the recruiting trail and the results were evident. According to Rivals.com, the Crimson Tide's 2020 recruiting class, which included Canada's No. 1 and No. 3-ranked players as well as the top JUCO prospect in the nation, was ranked No. 9 in the country by Scout.com and No. 12 according to 247Sports. In the classroom, the program boasted 11 student-athletes who earned SEC Academic Honor Roll recognition.
- Came to Alabama after spending the last four seasons at the University at Buffalo where he led the Bulls to a 96-43 (.691) record, three MAC Tournament Championships and three NCAA Tournament appearances, including reaching the round of 32 in each of the last two seasons
- Named the league's Coach of The Year and National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) District 14 Coach of the Year in back-to-back seasons (2018 and 2019) and finished fourth in voting for the 2019 Associated Press Men's College Coach of the Year
- Over the last two seasons, Buffalo finished with a combined record of 59-13 (.819), a pair of MAC Tournament and regular season championships, two NCAA Tournament Round of 32 appearances and consecutive MAC Coach of the Year honors


